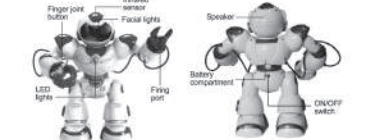

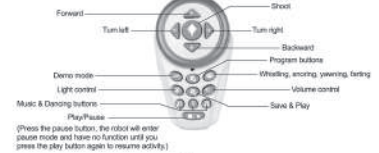
3. Do not allow children under age eight to play with your robot.

10. Your robot is not intended for commercial use.

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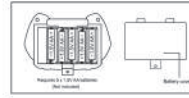
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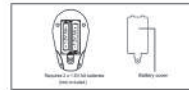
## 1. Unco

Once you have inserted `tutorial` into your robot

To do so, slide the ON/OFF switch located on the rear of the robot to the ON position.  
When you have finished playing with your robot, slide the ON/OFF switch to the OFF position.

**NOTE:** When your robot is running low on power, it will emit an audible tone and power down. Once the batteries are completely depleted, replace the batteries as soon as possible to continue use.

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You can use your remote control to move your robot around in different directions.

By pressing the left and right arrow buttons, your robot will turn left or right.



By pressing the forward/backward button once, the robot will walk forward/backward for a distance.  
By pressing the forward/backward button twice, the robot will slide forward/backward for a distance.  
By pressing the forward/backward button twice and keep pressing, the robot will slide forward/backward all the time.



Press the program button and your robot will enter

Once in program mode, you can press the directional buttons or shoot button a series of times to create a movement program. Press the save & play button to have your robot carry out the movement program that you created.

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Press the shoot button on your remote control and your robot will fire the projectile.
