# 1 Safety Notes

---



## **CAUTION:**

**Read these instructions carefully before assembly and use and keep for future reference.**

**The child may be hurt if you do not follow these instructions.**



## **WARNING:**

- This bassinet is intended for one child aged between 0-6 months, weighing up to a maximum of 9kg.
- The bassinet should be placed on a horizontal surface. Never leave the product on an inclined surface with the child inside.
- Young children should not be allowed to play unsupervised in the vicinity of bassinet.
- Inspect the bassinet before assembly and periodically during use. Do not use the bassinet if any part is broken, torn or missing.
- When a child is able to sit, kneel or to pull itself up, the bassinet shall no longer be used for this child.
- All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly and care should be taken to ensure no screws are loose as a child could trap parts of their body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies dummies, etc.) which pose a risk of strangulation.
- Do not use the bassinet without the frame.
- Use only the mattress supplied by the manufacturer. An incorrect mattress can cause death.
- Do not adjust the bassinet with the child inside.
- Do not move the bassinet with the child inside.
- Do not use the bassinet with more than one child at a time.
- Ensure the legs are fully adjusted before using bassinet. NEVER use bassinet with the legs partially or totally retracted.
- Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat such as electric bar fires, gas fires etc. in the near vicinity of the bassinet.
- Take care when unpacking and during assembly.
- Dispose of all packing materials carefully after assembly.
- Regularly check that all fittings remain tight. Tighten if required.

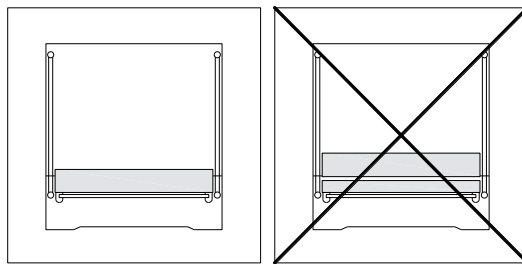

## WARNING:

- Any additional or replacement parts should only be obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.
- Never substitute parts.
- The bassinet sleep surface must be horizontal. Never place infant to sleep on a sloped surface.
- Placing additional items in the bassinet may cause suffocation.
- Do not place the bassinet close to another product as it may present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind/curtain cords, etc.
- The bassinet should be locked in the fixed position when the child is left unattended.
- Only use the mattress sold with this bassinet. DO NOT add a second mattress on top of the supplied mattress – it may cause a suffocation hazard.

## **WARNING:**

Failure to follow these warnings and the instructions could result in serious injury or death.

## **FALL HAZARD**

FALL HAZARD—To help prevent falls, do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or can sit up unaided or reach a Maximum weight of 9kg, whichever comes first.

## **SUFFOCATION HAZARD**

**Infants have suffocated:**

- **In gaps between extra padding and side of the bassinet / cradle.**
- **On soft bedding.**

**Use only the mattress provided by the manufacturer.**

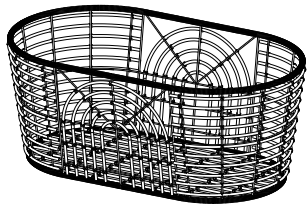
**NEVER add a pillow, comforter, or another mattress.**

To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.

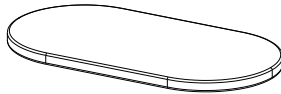

Bassinet



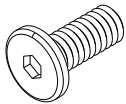
**B x 1**

Mattress



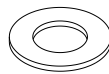
**C x 1**

Leg frame



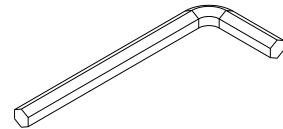

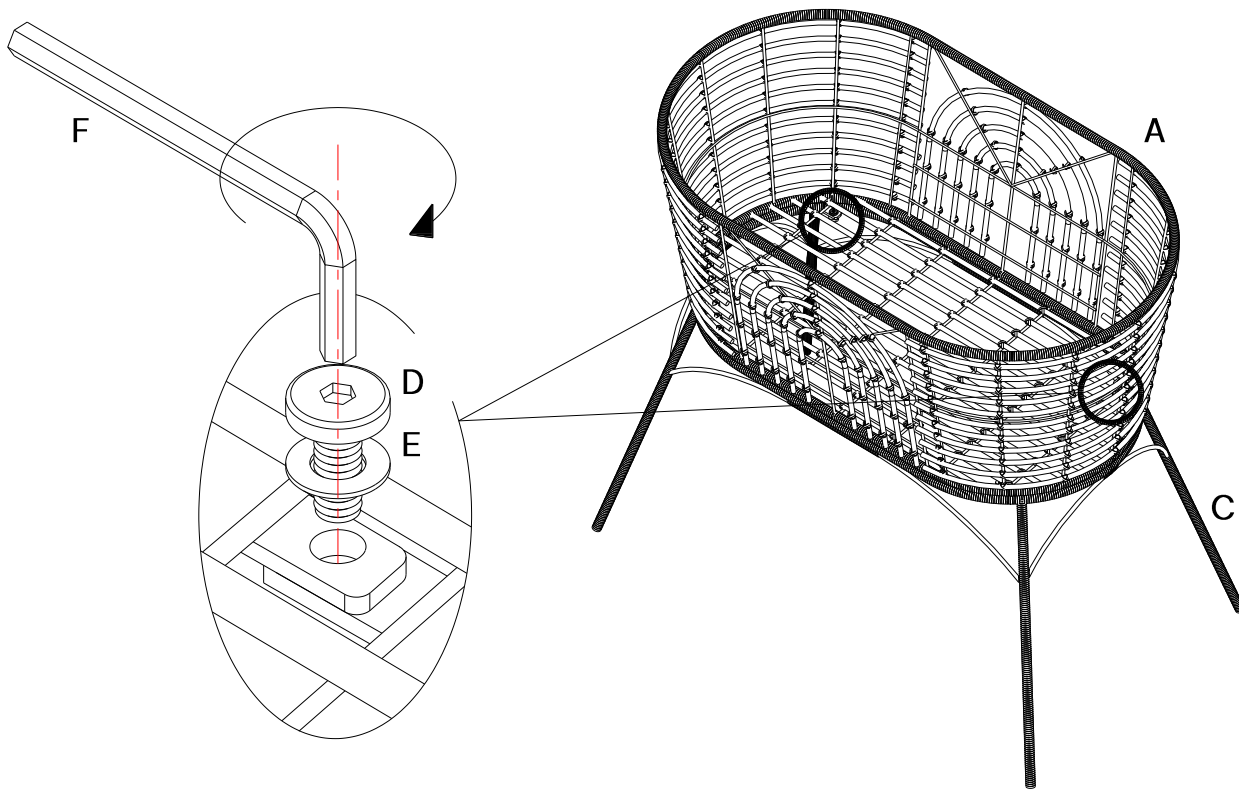

## 3.1 Assembly

---

Unpack all contents and check that all parts are present before commencing assembly. Please refer to the parts list.

1. Attached the Bassinet (A) into the Leg Frame (C) by using 4 Bolts (D) and 4 Washers (E) and fasten all Bolts securely using the Allen Key (F).



## 3.2 Assembly

---

1. Insert mattress into the bassinet.



### **WARNING:**

**Use only the mattress supplied by the manufacturer. An incorrect mattress can cause death.**



## 4 Care & Maintenance

---

- All assembly fittings are to be tightened properly. Inspect regularly and re-tighten as necessary.
- Do not use this bassinet if any parts are broken, torn or missing.
- Mattress: Surface clean only. Wipe with a damp cloth.
- Bassinet: Surface clean only. Wipe with a damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive pads, bleach or strong household cleaners.
- Ensure the bassinet is completely dry before use or storage.
- Always store in a clean and dry place. Avoid direct heat and sunlight.
