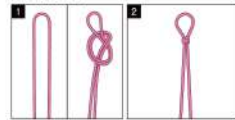
TIPS:

- After tying the strands in a loop knot, tape the knotted end on your desk to prevent the strands from sliding out. (tape not included)
- Make sure the strands lay flat and not twisted.
- Slide the beads through the base strands or side strands then continue knotting.
- Make sure the tension is distributed evenly between the strands.
- Keep the packaging nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.

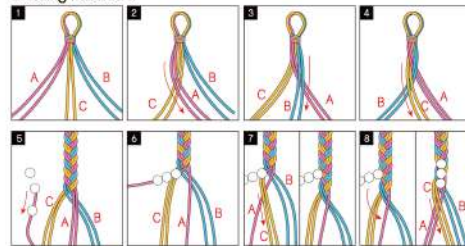
How to braid threads:

Tie a knot



Fold threads in half and tie with a small loop at the head. The number of threads can be adjusted according to the knitting needs.

Braiding method 1:



- Tie a knot with three threads and divide the threads into three parts by colour.
- Cross threads A over threads C.
- Cross threads B over threads A.
- Repeat steps 2-3 to complete the base braid.
- Add beads to one thread in your personal style.
- Set the thread with beads aside for now.
- Keep braiding the other threads to match the beads length.
- Braid all threads to a suitable length and tie a knot at the end.

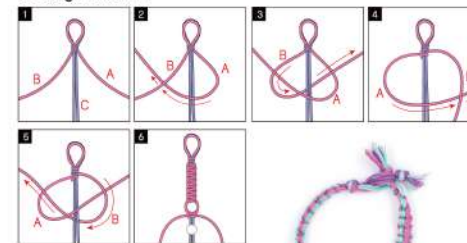


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Braiding method 2:



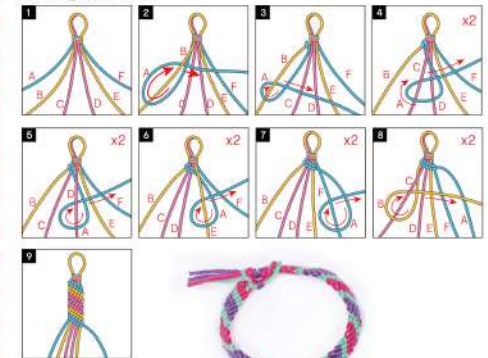
- Tie a knot with two threads, divide one thread on either side and keep the other in the middle.
- Cross thread A over middle threads C and under thread B.
- Cross thread B under middle threads C and through the loop over thread A, pull tight until the knot rises to the top of bracelet.
- Cross thread A over middle threads C and under thread B.
- Cross thread B under middle threads C and through the loop over thread A, pull tight until the knot rises to second row of bracelet.
- Slide the beads through middle threads C in the process of braiding. Repeat the process until the bracelet is the length that wraps loosely around your wrist and tie a knot at the end. (scissors not included)

Braiding method 3:



- Tie a knot with three threads, separate the threads based on colour symmetrically.
- Tie the thread A from the top right corner of the thread B.
- Tie the second knot on the thread B with thread A in the same way.
- 4-7. Tie the same two knots on the other threads from left to right with thread A. Then keep thread A on the right.
8. Start a new round of knotting from left to right with thread B.
9. Repeat the process until the bracelet is the length that wraps loosely around your wrist and tie a knot at the end. (scissors not included)
