VELVET

BABY JUMPER

Easy Knit

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MEASUREMENTS

- › Months 3 (6 – 9/12 – 18/24)
- › To fit underarm 40 (45–47/50–53/55) cm
- › To measure (approx) 46 (51–55–61) cm
- › Length (approx) 24 (27–30–32) cm
- › Sleeve length 14 (17–21–26) cm

MATERIALS

Velvet 100g

- › 1 (1–1–2) ball/s 1st Colour (C1–smokey green)
- › 1 (1–1–2) ball/s 2nd Colour (C2–quiet pink)

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- › A pair 5mm Knitting Needles, 1 spare 5mm Knitting
- › Needle or size that gives correct tension.
- › A yarn needle.

TENSION

- › 13 sts and 19 rows to 10cm over garter st, using 5mm needles.



JUMPER

First Sleeve

- › Using 5mm needles and C2, cast on 15 (17–18–20) sts.
- › Knit 3 rows garter st (1st row is WS).
- › Mark next row with a marker to identify the right side of work easily.
- › **4th row (RS)** – K1, inc in next st, knit to last 2 sts, inc in next st, K1 = 17 (19–20–22) sts.
- › Cont in garter st, inc one st (as before) at each end of every foll 4th (6th–6th–8th) row until there are 23 (25–26–28) sts.
- › Cont without shaping until work measures 14 (17–21–26) cm from beg, working last row on WS.
- › **Note** – Record the number of rows worked from last inc row to this point for other sleeve.

Beg Body

- › **Note** – When changing colours in the middle of a row, twist the colour to be used (on WS) underneath and to the right of the colour just used. Use a separate ball of yarn for each section of colour.
- › **1st row (RS)** – Using C2, cast on 3 sts, then using C1, cast on 16 (19–23–25) sts, work across these sts as follows – Using C1, K16 (19–23–25); Using C2, knit to end.
- › **2nd row (WS)** – Using C2, cast on 3 sts, then using C1, cast on 16 (19–23–25) sts, work across these sts as follows – Using C1, K16 (19–23–25); Using C2, knit to last 16 (19–23–25) sts; Using C1, K16 (19–23–25) = 61 (69–78–84) sts.
- › Keeping colour change correct, cont in garter st until work measures 6.5 (7.5–8.5–9.5) cm from cast on for Body, working last row on WS.
- › **Divide For Neck Opening – Next row** – K26 (30–34–37), cast off next 9 (9–10–10) sts for neck opening, knit to end.
- › Cont on these 26 (40–34–37) sts for 10 (11–11–12) cm, working last row on WS. Break off yarn. Leave sts on needle.
- › With WS facing, rejoin yarn to rem 26 (30–34–37) sts and using 5mm spare needle, cont for 10 (11–11–12) cm, working last row on WS.
- › **Joining row (RS)** – K26 (30–34–37), turn, cast on 9 (9–10–10) sts, turn, knit across 26 (30–34–37) sts from spare needle = 61 (69–78–84) sts.
- › Cont for 6.5 (7.5–8.5–9.5) cm from joining row, working last row on WS.
- › Keeping colours correct, cast off 19 (22–26–28) sts at beg of next 2 rows = 23 (25–26–28) sts.

Second Sleeve

- › Using C2 only for rem, work same amount of rows from this point to last st increased on other sleeve, working last row on WS.
- › **Next row** – K1, K2tog, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.
- › Cont dec one st (as before) at each end of every foll 4th (6th–6th–8th) row until 15 (17–18–20) sts rem.
- › Work 3 rows. Cast off loosely.

FINISHING

- › **DO NOT PRESS.** Using a flat seam, join side and sleeve seams. Darn in ends.
