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### STRIPE BLANKET Easy Knit

MEASUREMENTS

> Blanket (approx) 100 x 138cm

#### MATERIALS

Blanket Yarn 300g > 2 x balls 1st Colour (C1)

> 2 x balls 2nd Colour (C2)

#### NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- > An 8mm circular needle (80cm long) or size that gives correct tension.
- > A yarn needle.

#### TENSION

> 8 sts and 13 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 8mm circular needle.

#### BLANKET

- > Using 8mm circular needle and C1, cast on 80 sts loosely.
- > Note Work in rows, not rounds. Place a marker on 1st row to identify the RS of fabric easily.
- > Using C1, Beg double moss st 1st row (RS) \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.
- > 2nd row (WS) \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.
- > 3rd row \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.
- > 4th row \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.
- > Rows 1 to 4 incl form double moss st.
- > Cont in double moss st for 7.5cm (from beg), working last row on WS. Break off C1.
- > \*\* Using C2, Next row (RS) Knit, to prevent pips showing.
- > Work in double moss st for 7.5cm, working last row on WS. Break off C2.
- > Using C1, Next row (RS) Knit, to prevent pips showing.
- > Work in double moss st for 7.5cm, working last row on WS. Break off C1. \*\*
- > Rep from \*\* to \*\* until work measures approx 138cm, ending with 7.5cm of C1.
- > Do not break off yarn. Using C1, cast off loosely.

#### FINISHING

> DO NOT PRESS. Darn in ends neatly towards centre of blanket rather than along side edges.







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
