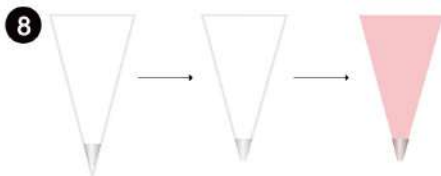


106x150mm (折后尺寸)



Place the tip into the piping bag, cut a small opening to fit and pour the whipped wax into the bag.



Squeeze the whipped wax from the piping bag into the cup.



Before the candle fully dries, add the strawberry to secure to the top and press firmly. Then your candle is ready to use or display.

## Strawberry Sundae Candle Kit Instruction Manual

### Kit Includes

- › 1 x glass jar
- › 2 x bags of soy wax
- › 1 x silicone mould
- › 1 x candle fragrance
- › 1 x wick
- › 1 x wick holder
- › 1 x glue dot
- › 1 x whisk
- › 1 x piping bag and tip
- › 2 x wax dyes
- › 2 x wooden sticks
- › 1 x instruction sheet

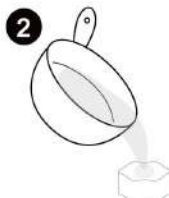
### Tips

- › Keep the jar still during the setting process, ensuring the bottom of the candle is flat.
- › Pour the wax into the jar in three stages. Tap the jar during the pouring process to reduce air bubbles.

### How To Make Strawberry Candles



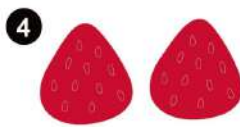
Add 10-15g soy wax and wax dye colour chips to a heat resistant container, heat and stir well with a wooden stick until all wax is melted and dye has dissolved completely.



Cool the wax for a few minutes, then pour it into the strawberry mould and wait for it to cool completely.



Gently demould after the wax has completely dried to reveal your candle.



Repeat steps 1-3 to make the second strawberry.

### How To Make A Sundae Candle Jar



Secure the wick on the base using the glue dot. Place the wick holder on top of the jar and secure the wick in place.



Add 65g soy wax and wax dye colour chips to a heat resistant container, heat and stir well with a wooden stick until all wax is melted and dye has dissolved completely.



Cool the wax for a few minutes, then pour it into the jar. Fill the jar until 1/3 full. Allow the wax to set completely.



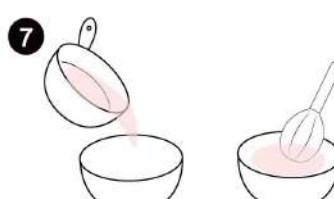
Add 65g soy wax to a heat resistant container, heat and stir well with a wooden stick until all wax is melted.



Cool the wax for a few minutes, then pour it into the jar. Fill the jar until 2/3 full. Allow the wax to set completely.



Add 85g soy wax and wax dye colour chips to a heat resistant container as per step 2.



Pour the melted soy wax into a container (not included) and stir with a whisk until creamy.
