

BASIC CROCHET STITCH DIAGRAM

1. Stitch (Abbreviated 'st')

Slip knot

Every piece of crochet chain starts with a slip knot. Loop the yarn around two fingers (leaving a tail) and pull the tail halfway through the loop. Insert the crochet hook into the second loop and gently pull the loop taut onto the crochet hook.



2. Chain Stitch (Abbreviated 'ch')

The chain stitch is the flattest or shallowest of all crochet stitches. You can use this stitch to slip-stitch the ends of a foundation chain to form a ring.



3. Slip Stitch (Abbreviated 'sl st')

The slip stitch is the flattest or shallowest of all crochet stitches. You can use this stitch to slip-stitch the ends of a foundation chain to form a ring.



4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'sc')

The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches. Gather the yarn with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull it through two loops, leaving one loop on the hook.



5. Increase (Abbreviated 'inc')

You can increase stitches by adding a stitch at the beginning of the row. For example, make 2 sc in the same knot.



6. Decrease (Abbreviated 'dec')

You can decrease stitches, which is really just subtracting a stitch, in a row. Make a half sc, at which point there are 2 loops in the hook, then crochet a half sc in the next knot, at which point there are 3 loops in the hook, and finally wind the yarn through all 3 loops to finish a dec.



7. Double Crochet (Abbreviated 'dc')

The double crochet is one of the most common crochet stitches and is about twice as tall as a single crochet. Wrap the yarn around the crochet hook. Then insert the crochet hook into the next stitch loop. Wrap the yarn with your crochet hook and pull the loop through the stitch (three loops now on the hook). Wrap the yarn around the hook again and pull it through the first two loops, leaving two loops on the hook. Then, wrap the yarn around the hook again and bring it through the remaining two loops to leave only one loop on the hook. Complete the row.



8. Half Double Crochet (Abbreviated 'hdc')

Wrap the yarn around the hook then insert the hook into the next stitch. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull through all loops.



9. Round (Abbreviated 'Rd')

This continues the chain stitches into a circle. Each round starts with ch and ends with sl st.

10. Sewing

Generally used for the connection of 2 parts. The plastic needle strap yarns are threaded in turn through the knots where the two parts need to be connected.



If details need to be stitched onto the finished product (such as mouth, eyes, etc.) Use the plastic needle and thread to create small stitches to represent facial features etc.



11. Fasten Off (Abbreviated 'F/O')

Fasten off by pulling the yarn through the end stitch and pulling it taut. Cut off.



12. Weaving In/Invisible Close

Cut the yarn, leaving a long yarn end. Draw the end through the final loop on the hook and thread it onto a yarn needle. Weave your needle through the front loops only on the last round and pull tight! Weave remaining yarn into your piece.



Please noted that all yarns needs to be hidden behind the stitch.

13. Insert Your Hook Into 2nd Back Hoop



14. Magic Ring

A magic ring is an adjustable starting round used for crochet amigurumi patterns, granny squares and other patterns that work in crochet rounds. Form a loop with your yarn. You will need to loop the yarn around your fingers, insert the hook through the loop. Slide the working end of the yarn taut while gently pulling down on the tail end. As you do this, the stitches should close together at the center, completing your magic ring. Finally, slip stitch into the first stitch. To close this round and start the remainder of your pattern, make a slip stitch into the first stitch of your ring, and proceed to the next round.



STITCHES USED

ch chain
sl slip stitch
sc single crochet
inc increase
dec decrease

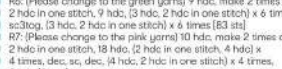
MAKE A CROCHET HEART PILLOW

1. Heart pieces x 2

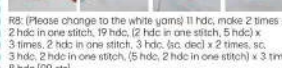
R1: (Please use the pink yarn) 8 ch, insert your hook into 2nd back hoop to make 2 dc, make 2 times of 3 dc in one stitch, dc, 7 dc in one stitch, 4 dc in turn, 6 dc in one stitch (23 sts)
R2: (Please change to the white yarn) 5 hdc, 3 hdc in one stitch, 4 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 3 hdc in one stitch, 2 hdc in one stitch, sc, sc3tog, sc, 2 hdc in one stitch, 3 hdc in one stitch, 2 hdc in one stitch, hdc (32 sts)
R3: (Please change to the red yarn) 6 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 6 hdc, make 6 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, inc, 2 dec, inc, make 6 times of 2 hdc in one stitch (46 sts)



R4: (Please change to the orange yarn) 9 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 9 hdc, (hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 6 times, 2 sc, dec, 2 sc, (hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 6 times (59 sts)
R5: (Please change to the yellow yarn) 8 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 8 hdc, (hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch, hdc) x 6 times, dec, sc, dec, 12 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch x 6 times (71 sts)
R6: (Please change to the green yarn) 9 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 9 hdc, (3 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 6 times, sc3tog, 13 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch x 6 times (83 sts)
R7: (Please change to the pink yarn) 10 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 18 hdc, (2 hdc in one stitch, 4 hdc) x 4 times, dec, sc, dec, (4 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 4 times, 8 hdc (91 sts)



R8: (Please change to the white yarn) 11 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 19 hdc, (2 hdc in one stitch, 5 hdc) x 3 times, 2 hdc in one stitch, 3 hdc, (sc, dec) x 2 times, sc, 3 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch, (5 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 3 times, 8 hdc (99 sts)
R9: (Please change to the red yarn) 12 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 23 hdc, (2 hdc in one stitch, 6 hdc) x 3 times, 2 hdc in one stitch, hdc, dec, sc, dec, hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch, (6 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 3 times, 11 hdc (107 sts)
R10: (Please change to the blue yarn) 13 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 29 hdc, (2 hdc in one stitch, 7 hdc) x 2 times, 2 hdc in one stitch, 4 hdc, dec, sc, dec, 4 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch, (7 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 2 times, 16 hdc (115 sts)



R11: (Please change to the white yarn) 14 hdc, make 2 times of 2 hdc in one stitch, 28 hdc, (4 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch twice) x 5 times, dec, sc, dec, (4 hdc, 2 hdc in one stitch) x 5 times, 14 hdc (123 sts) F/O



2. Sewing all the parts
1. Use the plastic needle to sew 2x finished heart pieces. (Fig. 1)
2. When stitching up to the end, fill with the fiberfill.
3. Once finished, hide the excess threads inside the pillow.
Now, you have finished a crochet heart pillow. (Fig. 2)

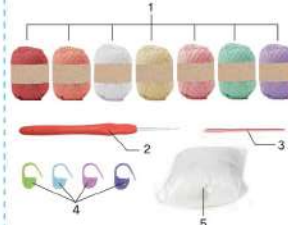
