Safety Instructions

- 1. Do not disassemble this product.
- 2. The speaker and microphone shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and objects filled with liquids.
- 3. Do not expose speaker and microphone to water while charging. It may result in permanent damage to the units or power source.
- Keep the units away from direct sunlight, fire flames or other heat sources and high voltage equipment.
- 5. Working temperature: $-10^{\circ}C 40^{\circ}C$.
- To prolong battery lifespan, fully charge at least once every 3 months. Battery life will vary due to usage patterns and environmental conditions.

Speaker Function Operation

Play: Press 🕁 button

Pause: Press 🕁 button

Disconnect Bluetooth®: Press 🕁 button twice

Next Track: Press and hold + button

Previous Track: Press and hold - button

Volume Up: Press + button

Volume Down: Press - button

Power ON / OFF: Press and hold & button

Lights ON / OFF: Press M button twice

Light Colour Change: Press and hold M button

Mode Switch: Press M button to toggle between USB / TF / Bluetooth®

Bluetooth® Pairing

Press and hold the (3) (4) button until LED light turns on and you will hear a prompt sound, indicating it is ready to pair with a Bluetooth® device. In the Bluetooth® menu on the media device, search for **"anko43559787**" and connect. You will hear a prompt sound once the speaker is connected successfully.

TF Card Mode (TF Card not included)

Insert TF card (up to 32GB) into (6) TF Card slot. It will play an audio track automatically.

USB Mode (USB Drive not included)

Plug in USB (USB Disk up to 64GB) to the O USB Port. It will play audio track automatically.

Note: When both USB Disk and TF cards are plugged in, it will read USB Disk first.

Microphone Function Operation

The microphone will automatically pair with the speaker when both are turned on. When using the microphone, do not hold the microphone too close to the speaker to prevent interference. Try to stay at least 1m apart.

Microphone Power ON / OFF: Press and hold \oplus button

Volume Mode: Press ▷ to switch between Mic, Music or Reverb Volume Mode

Volume Up: Press + to increase respective volume under different volume model

Volume Down: Press - to decrease respective volume under different volume model

Next Track: Press and hold + button

Previous Track: Press and hold - button

Microphone Mute / Unmute: Press and hold ▷ button

Magic Voice: Press % button to switch to magic voice (4 different magic voices) **Vocal ON / OFF**: Press and hold % turn vocal ON / OFF

Charging

This Speaker and Wireless Microphone are powered by rechargeable battery. Please use provided USB-C charging cable for charging. Plug the USB-C cable end into the unit and other USB-A end into a wall charger or other 5V charging devices.
