### **Technical Maintenance**


- Make sure that all parts remain clean, free of dust, dirt or sand.
- For cleaning the scooter, use a damp cloth.
- Lubricate the moving parts only when it is necessary (apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant).
- Periodically check the scooter for the presence of loosely tightened screws or worn-out parts.
- Replace or repair the parts as necessary.
- Store the scooter in a dry place.
- Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight may cause deformation of the plastic parts.

# **Assembly**

#### Installation of the handlebar:

### Press the locking button and insert the handlebar into the stand as shown in the top illustration.

#### Note:


In order to pull out the handlebar, it is necessary to press the locking button.

# Handlebar height adjustment:

Turn the top clamp to the side as shown in the figure.

While holding the regulator button, raise or lower the handlebar until the button pops out of the hole.

To finally lock the handlebar, be sure to return the eccentric lever to its original position.



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
