




# **Presentations For Connection Way:**

# 1. Connect the Water Supply

Attach your own garden hose (not included) to Port A, and connect the other end to your faucet.




Quick Connector attach with tap

# 2. Set Up the Brush Attachment

- First, connect the hose (with a quick connector) to Port B.
- Then, connect the brush handle (Joint C) to Port B using the quick-connect system.
- Use the black button (Joint D) to control the water flow.
  When the button is aligned straight, the water is on.
- Rotate the button 90° to turn the water off.

# 3. Add Detergent

- Unscrew the detergent bottle (Fitting G).
- Pour in your preferred car cleaning detergent.
- Screw the bottle back on securely.



#### 4. Activate the Brush




- Turn on your water tap to allow water to flow through the brush.
- The rotating gear inside the brush head will begin to spin automatically.



# 5. Adjust Detergent Flow


 Use the dial knob to control how much detergent is mixed with the water—adjust according to your cleaning needs.






# 6. Use the Main Handle Separately (Optional)

 You can unscrew the main handle (Part E) to use it for rinsing off detergent or even for watering plants.



#### 7. Choose Handle Length (Optional)

- Based on your preference, you can use 1 or 2 handle extensions for extra reach.
- Please refer to the final image in the manual for guidance on attaching the extension handles properly.



# ⚠ General Warnings & Precautions

- Ensure all connections are secure before turning on the water supply to prevent leaks or accidental disconnection.
- Avoid applying excessive pressure while cleaning to prevent scratching vehicle surfaces or damaging the brush head.
- Always turn off the water and release pressure before detaching any parts or storing the product.
