- 7. Only use the provided USB cable and recommended power source for charging.
- 8. Stop using immediately if you notice unusual heat, odor, smoke, or noise during operation or charging.

How to Use

- > Control with no remote:
- 1. Press button to control the fan speed. Press once for low wind, press twice for mid wind, press three times for max wind. Press again to turn the fan off.
- 2. Press button to control the light. Press once for low brightness, press twice for mid brightness, press three times for max brightness. Press again to turn the light off.
- Control with remote:
- 1. Use the remote to control the fan and light without pressing the control panel on the fan.
- 2. Press (8)(9)(14) button to set timer

Power display shows the battery power. Charge the battery using the provided USB cable. The indicator light will flash to show 25% 50% 75% 100% battery until the fan is fully charged. Hang the device by the hook if required.

This device could be used as a temporary power bank in case of emergency.

Caution

- 1. Danger of explosion if battery is incorrectly replaced. Replace only with the same or equivalent type.
- 2. Battery cannot be subjected to high or low extreme temperatures, low air pressure at high altitude during use, storage or transportation.
- 3. Replacement of a battery with an incorrect type that can result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid or gas.
- 4. Disposal of a battery into fire or a hot oven, or mechanically crushing or cutting of a battery, that can result in an explosion.
- 5. Leaving a battery in an extremely high temperature surrounding environment that can result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid or gas.
- 6. A battery subjected to extremely low air pressure that may result in an explosion or the leakage of flammable liquid or gas.
- 7. Charge the product fully before first use.
- 8. Do not leave unattended while charging.
- 9. Only charge using 5V USB power (e.g., power bank, laptop, or USB wall charger).
- 10. Do not expose battery compartment to moisture or excessive heat.
- 11. Dispose of batteries responsibly and according to local regulations.

Care & Maintenance Instructions

- 1. Clean the fan and light surface with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Do not use harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials to clean any part of the unit.
- 3. Store in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- 4. Ensure the fan is completely turned off and unplugged before cleaning or storing.
- 5. For long-term storage, charge the battery to at least 50% to maintain battery health.
- 6. Check that the remote control is free from corrosion or battery leakage before each use.
