SAVE THIS INSTRUCTION

- 1. Only use the appliance as described in this manual.
- 2. Do not allow the appliance to be exposed to rain or moisture during use or storage.
- 3. Always check the appliance for damage prior to use. If any damage is observed, do not use the appliance.
- 4. The appliance is intended for indoor use only.
- 5. Always switch the appliance off after use.
- 6. This appliance has no user serviceable parts. Do not attempt to access the appliance covers.
- 7. This appliance is for personal use only, not designed for commercial use.
- 8. Do not use it outdoors.
- 9. Do not use the appliance if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or if it has been immersed in any liquid.
- 10. Do not use the appliance on children.
- 11. The appliance is not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- 12. Children being supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- 13. Only charge the appliance with the USB cable that was supplied with the appliance.
- 14. Only Charge the appliance with Extra Low Voltage Battery Charger (not supplied) with an output rating 5Vd.c. 2A, same as indicated on the appliance's rating lable.
- 15. When charging the appliance, make sure it is switched OFF.
- 16. Check that your supply voltage is the same as that stated on the charger.
- 17. DO not use over insensitive skin areas or in the presence of poor circulation.
- 18. Use only attachments provided.
- 19. Do not replace the batteries with non-rechargeable batteries.
- 20. Do not use cleaning products that are designed for toilets, bathrooms or kitchen appliances to clean the unit.



WARNING: Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.



WARNING: Before charging the product, please make sure your hands are dry.



WARNING: Only use the USB cable supplied with the appliance. Use of other cable may cause electrical failure and/or fire.



This devise is not to be used for commercial or medical purposes. If you have health concerns, consult your doctor before using the roller massager.

Only use the USB cable that was supplied with this Appliance.

- Do not use or store in temperatures above 40°C.




At the end of the appliance's life, it must be disposed of correctly.

CHARGING

IMPORTANT: This Appliance contains a built-in lithium-ion battery which must only be charged using the supplied USB cable.

Always switch off an dunplug the USB cable when charging is completed or when not in use.

DO NOT allow to charge for more than 4 hours.

Normal charge takes approximately 3 hours.

If any abnormality occurs during charging, (such as burning smell or excessive heat or even a strange sound) immediately turn off the charger and disconnect the USB cable.

IMPORTANT: The Appliance must be fully charged before first use.

- Take the USB Cable and fully unravel it before using it to charge the Appliance.
- Plug the small end of the USB cable directly into the bottom of the appliance.
- Plug the large end of the USB cable into your 5Vd.c. 2A USB charger (not supplierd) and switch on.
- As the battery charges to approximately 25%, one LED will on, then as the battery continues to charge to approximately 50%, the second LED will on.
- When full charged, all 4 LEDs will illuminates.
- When charging is completed, disconnet the USB charging cable from the appliance.
- When the massage intensity is reduced, stop using the massager. Connect it to a power supply to recharge.




If the 4 LED lights are not illuminated after 6 hours of charging, disconnect the charging cable. This could be due to a malfunction.

Do not continue to charge the battery.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Vibrating roller massager provides 1 massage mode and 3 massage intensity levels, which can be selected by pressing the On/Off button.



- 1. Press and hold the On/Off button to turn on the unit.
- Keep pressing the On/off button to cycle from Speed 1-Speed 2-Auto mode-Speed 3. Corresponding LED will illuminate RED to indicate the speed/mode selected.
- 3. Automatic mode provides changing vibration intensity, cycling from weak to strong or from strong to weak.
- 4. Press and hold the On/Off button to stop the unit.
- 5. Never work too long with the Roller. The unit will automatically shut down after 15minutes operation.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- 1. Before you clean, make sure the unit is switched off and charging cable has been pulled out from the socket.
- 2. Use a dry cloth to clean the product.
- 3. Keep the product clean and store away in a dry location away from moisture.
