

# 1080P Smart Projector User Manual

### Warning:

- 1. The projector is non dustproof or waterproof.
- In order to reduce the risk of fire and electric shock, do not expose the projector to rain and fog.
- When projector is working, please do not look directly into the lens, the strong light will flash your eyes and cause slight pain. Children should use the projector under the supervision of adults.
- 4. Do not cover the vents of projector. Heating will reduce the life of projector and cause danger.
- Regularly clean projector vents, or dust may cause cooling malfunction.
- Do not use the projector in greasy, damp, dusty or smoky environment.Oil or chemicals will cause malfunction.
- 7. Please handle with care during daily use.
- 8. Please cut off the power if the projector is out of use for long time.
- Please pay attention to important information related to the operation and maintenance of the projector. You should read this information carefully to avoid problems. Following safetu instructions will increase the life of projector.
- Please consult the qualified personnel for installation and repair services, and do not use damaged wires, accessories and other peripherals.
- Projector should be kept away from flammable, explosive, strong electromagnetic interference (large radar stations, power stations, substations etc.), strong ambient light (avoid direct sunlight), etc.










### Power Cord



# Remote Component and Functions



### Note:

- 1. Requires 2 x 1.5V AAA batteries for remote control (Not included)
- Press "Input Source" to enter HDMI or USB playing.
  - 3. Press "Switch to mouse control" to enter or exist the mouse mode.

### Power on

1. Connect the power cord to the projector, then plug it into a suitable power outlet.


- 2. Press the Power button on the projector or on the remote control to turn it on.
- 3. Adjust the focus wheel until the projected image is clear.
- Connect the projector to your home network for enhanced functionality. For details, refer to the **Network** section.



### Home Screen and Desktop Switching

To switch to an alternative Android-style desktop interface:

- On the main home screen, select the "Desktops" icon (purple tile).
- 2. The system will switch to a more minimalist interface with black background.
- 3. You can access apps such as YouTube, Google Play Store, or return to the original desktop.
- 4. To switch back, click the "Desktop" icon again from the new interface.



# USB playback


Insert a USB flash drive or USB hard drive (up to 256GB supported) into the projector. Then, either press the **OK** button on the remote control, or select the **Source** icon on the home screen and choose **USB** to access the file list.

### Supported files formats for USB input:

VIDEO FORMAT: DAT/MPEG/MPG/TS/MP4/AVI/MOV/MKV AUDIO FORMAT: MP2/MP3/WAV/OGG/FLAC/AAC/M4A IMAGE FORMAT: JPEG/BMP/GIF/PNG



USB drive inserted select your file from device and press the "OK" button to enter.



# HDMI playback

- 5. Insert the HDMI cable into the projector.
- Select Source icon on the home screen or press Input Source on the remote control, then choose HDMI to begin plauback.



Note: When HDMI is connected, if you exit the HDMI input manually and wish to return to it, follow the steps below:

- Press the Home button on the remote control to exit HDMI playback.
- On the home screen, select the Source icon, or press the Input Source button on the remote control, then select HDMI to return to the HDMI input channel.

# Wi-Fi Connection

Go to **Settings > Network**. Set **WLAN** to **ON**. Select the desired Wi-Fi network (SSID) from the list. Enter the correct password and confirm to establish the internet connection.



# Bluetooth connection

Go to Settings > Bluetooth, select Device Scan, then choose the target device to pair.



# Projection Settings


Go to Settings > Projection Settings to configure:

- Projection Mode
- Screen Zoom
- Trapezoidal Correction Mode
- Vertical Correction
- Horizontal Correction
- Upper & Lower Correction



# **Google Account Settings**

Go to Settings > Google Account to log in or log out of your Google account.



# System Configurations

# Language Setup

Go to **Settings > Language** to select the desired language.



### Time & Time zone

Go to **Settings > Time & Time Zone** to set the current time, choose between 12-hour or 24-hour clock format, and configure the time zone.



# Upgrade

Go to Settings > Upgrade, perform firmware updates either online or local.



# Reset

Go to Settings > Reset to restore the projector to factory default settings.



# Input Source setting

Go to Settings > Input Source Setting to enable or disable the CEC and ARC functions.



### Sound mode

Go to Settings > Sound Mode, select the desired sound profile: Standard, Theatre, Classical.



# Image Mode

Go to **Settings > Image Mode**, to choose the preferred image mode: Bright Mode, Vivid Mode, Movie Mode, Sports Mode, Self Definition.



### Screen Saver

Go to **Settings** > **Screen Saver**, to enable or disable the screen saver function. When enabled, you may select one of the following timeout options: 5, 10, 15, 20, or 30 minutes.

# Screen Mirroring Setup (Android/iOS Devices)

Ensure that your Android (phone, tablet, etc.) or Apple devices (iPhone, iPad, etc.) are connected to the **same local Wi-Fi network** as the projector.

# Option 1: Connection via Eshare app:

1.On the projector, go to the Home Screen and select J-Share.

2.Launch the EShare app on your mobile device.

3.Enable the Phone Mirroring function within the app.

4. From the list of available devices, select "anko43592654" to establish the connection.

### Option 2: App-Free Connection

1.On the projector, open the **settings panel (lower-right corner**), and enable both **AirPlay** and **Miracast**.

2.For Android devices: connect via Miracast.

3.For Apple devices: connect via AirPlay.
