Paint Your Own Christmas Plaster Set



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
- 2. Cover your work area with newspaper or paper towels.
- 3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
- 4. Put on an apron or art smock before you paint.
- 5. Keep a cup of water near to thoroughly wash the paint brush after applying each colour.
- 6. Close the paint lids after each use to prevent paint from drying.

TIPS:

- Add some water to the paints if they look too dry or sticky.
- Let the painted plasters dry completely after you have finished painting.
- Refer to the packaging box as inspiration when painting, or create your own designs.
- 4. Mix different paints together to create new colours.

Note:

- 1. Mixing Red and White will make a shade close to Pink.
- 2. Mixing Green and White will make a Light Green shade.
