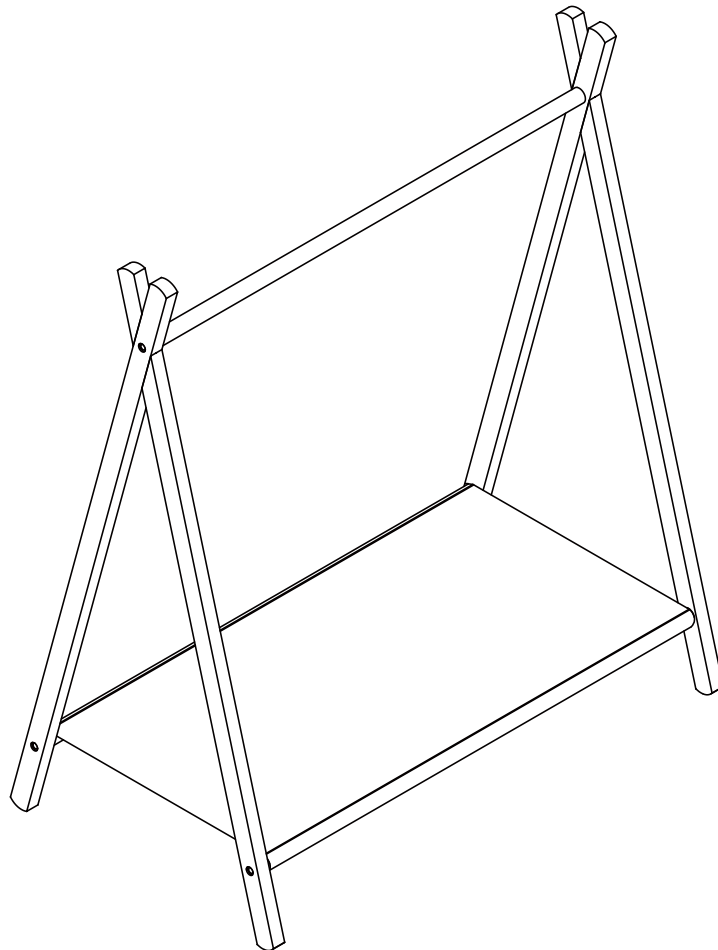

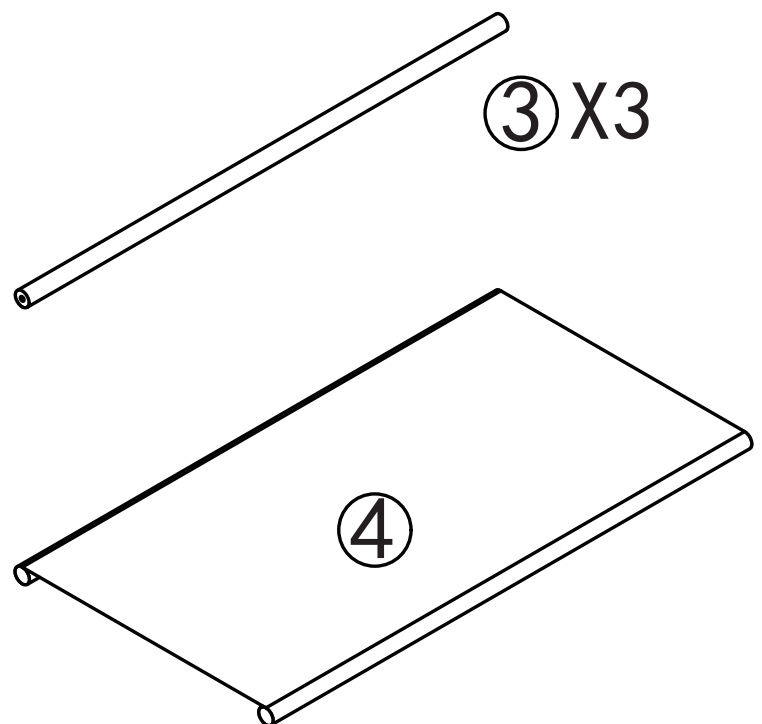
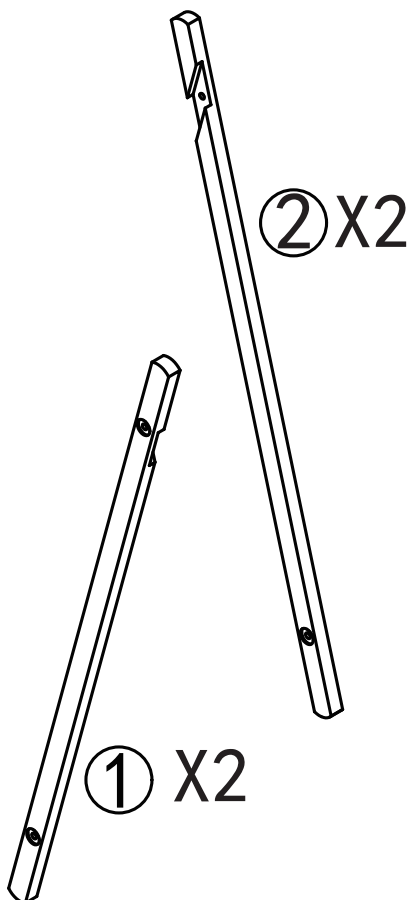
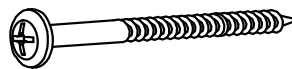

WARNING!

- Adult assembly required.
- Read all the instructions before assembly and use of the product.
- Take care when unpacking and during assembly.

- Regularly check that all fittings remain tight. Tighten if required.
- Inspect the product before assembly and periodically during use. Never use this product if there are any loose or missing fasteners, joints or broken parts.
- Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc., in the near vicinity of this product.
- For indoor use only. Always use this product on a flat level floor.
- Any additional or replacement parts should only be obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.
- Never substitute parts.
- This item is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with it.

Care and maintenance:

- Wipe the wooden frame and shelf with a soft, damp cloth if required and dry thoroughly.
- Do not soak, submerge, or expose wooden components to excessive moisture or direct sunlight.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, bleach, or harsh chemicals, as these may damage the wood or finishes.
- Regularly inspect the structure for signs of wear, damage, or splinters. Discontinue use if any component is compromised.
- Store in a dry, well-ventilated area when not in use.
- When moving the nursery clothes rack, always lift and place in position. Do not drag the nursery clothes rack as damage may result.
