

How to inflation

Remove all contents from the packaging and lay them out in a clean, flat

Take out the white projection screen and attach it securely to the inflatable frame. Close all zippers completely. Ensure that the inflatable frame is positioned with the white screen facing upward.



Unpack the air blower and connect the lip tightly to the air intake sleeve on the frame using the attached fastening row Ensure the blower is placed in an open area, free of obstructions that


Plug the power cord into a **suitable power outlet**, and turn the switch to the **"ON"** position to begin inflation.

This may take several minutes. **Ensure that all zippers are fully closed** to allow proper inflation.

Once fully inflated, stand the screen upright carefully, ensuring the



For outdoor use, secure the inflatable frame using ropes and stakes: Pass the ropes through each of the **six anchoring points**, tightly with the provided stakes into stable ground.






How to Deflate and Store

1. Detach and neatly **fold the white screen**, and store it in a dry, safe Switch the blower power button to the "OFF" position or unplug it from

3. Fold in half 3 times vertically. Open the air-release zipper to begin



 $4. \ Fasten \ with \ a \ rope \ and \ Place \ in \ carry \ bag. \ Once \ fully \ deflated, \ fold \ the \ inflatable \ vertically \ into \ thirds. \ Secure \ the \ folded \ unit \ with \ a \ rope \ or$ strap and place it into the carry bag for storage.



Storage Tips:

1. Ensure the product is completely dry before storing to prevent mold or material damage.

2. Store in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated location away from direct

Usage tips:

Inspect the blower thoroughly before each use. If any part is

Drying & Storage

Blower starts then stops: Remove any obstructions from inlet/outlet

 Blower vibrates: Check for bent motor shaft or fan blades; straighten or replace if necessary. Clean accumulated dirt or dust.

Scraping noises: Inspect the blower housing for dents or warps.
Ensure nothing contacts the fan blade during operation.

Motor runs but blower does not turn: Inspect motor and shaft for
