How To Make A Pudding Photo Stand

1



Take one quarter of the air-dry clay. Using the roller, roll it out into a flat circle about 20cm thick.

2



Using the pudding template as a guide, mould the clay into a pudding using the cutting tool and your hands. Make sure to flatten the bottom, so it will stand up.

3



Create a small, deep slit at the top using the cutting tool. Use some water to smooth the clay.

4



Use dry remaining air-dry clay offcuts to make four small leaves using the template as a guide, and roll four small balls between your hands, as shown.

6



Using the cutting tool, slightly roughen the surface where you want to place the leaves and balls. Use a little water to wet the sides, then gently press to attach two small leaves and two small balls to each side.

6



Use some water to smooth the clay. Make sure that the top of the pudding is not closed. Then lay the photo stand on a flat surface to dry overnight.

7



Paint the photo stand with your desired pattern and leave to dry.

8



After the photo stand has dried completely, you can put your photo in it.

Tips

- Set up the workspace with a place mat to protect the surface.
- Divide the clay into four even pieces, one for each photo stand.
- Add water to smooth the clay.

How To Make A Christmas Tree Photo Stand

1



Take one quarter of the air-dry clay. Using the roller, roll it out into a flat circle about 20cm thick.

2



Using the tree template as a guide, mould the clay into a tree using the cutting tool and your hands. Make sure to flatten the bottom, so it will stand up.

3



Create a small, deep slit at the top using the cutting tool.

4



Use some water to smooth the clay, then lay the photo stand on a flat surface to dry overnight.

5



Paint the photo stand with your desired pattern and leave to dry.

How To Make A Gingerbread Man Photo Stand

1



Take one quarter of the air-dry clay. Using the roller, roll it out into a flat circle about 20cm thick.

Using the gingerbread man template as a guide, mould the clay into the shape using the cutting tool and your hands. Make sure to flatten the bottom, so it will stand up.

3



Create a small, deep slit at the top using the cutting tool.

4



Use some water to smooth the clay, then lay the photo stand on a flat surface to dry overnight.

5



Paint the photo stand with your desired pattern and leave to dry.

6



After the photo stand has dried completely, you can put your photo in it.

How To Make A Bow Photo Stand

1



Take one quarter of the air-dry clay. Using the roller, roll it out into a flat circle about 20cm thick.

Using the bow template as a guide, mould the clay into a bow using the cutting tool and your hands. Make sure to flatten the bottom, so it will stand up.

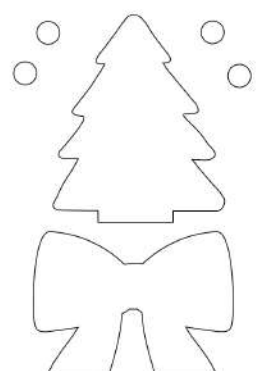
