Operating Instructions:

1. Power on/off:

Press and hold the Power button (⏻) for 3 seconds to turn on/off the camera.

2. Take Photography:

After turning on the camera, half press the Camera button (○) until the focus frame on the screen change to green, then you can press the Camera button (○) to take a photo.

3. Video Recording:

Press the Mode button (Ⓜ) to switch to Video Mode, press the Camera button (○) to start recording the video, and then press the Camera button (○) to end recording.

4. Playback Mode:

Press the Mode button (Ⓜ) to switch to Playback Mode, then press Left (⬅) /Right (➡) Button to select files, press OK Button (Ⓚ) to playback video or photo.

5. Delete Video and Photo:

In Playback Mode, you can press the Left (⬅) /Right Button (➡) to select the files need to delete, and press the Down Button (⬇) to choose "delete current" or "delete all".

6. System settings:

Press the Mode button (Ⓜ) to switch to the System Settings Mode, press the Up (⬆) /Down (⬇) Button to select submenus, then press the OK button (Ⓚ) to confirm, and then press the Mode button (Ⓜ) to exit the system menu.

7. Video and Photo settings:

Under Video/Photo Mode, press the Menu button (Ⓜ) to enter the Video/Photo Mode settings.

8. Auto focus:

Press and hold the Camera button (○) halfway, and the camera will automatically focus. The focus frame on the screen will change to green to complete the focus. Then you can press the Camera button (○) fully to capture the current image (during this process, keep the camera still and do not release the Camera button (○)).

9. Selfie Mode:

Press and hold the OK button (Ⓚ) for 3 seconds to switch between front and rear screens. this allows you to quickly activate selfie mode.

10. Effects

Press the Menu button (Ⓜ) to open the menu options, locate and select the "Effect" option, you can choose (Auto / B&W / Sepia / Negative / Embossment).

11. Battery Charging:

You can use the provided USB charging cable to charge the camera through an adapter (5V/1A). When charging, the red indicator light will light up, and when fully charged, the red indicator light will turn off.

12. Connect PC:

Using the provided USB charging cable to connect to the

computer, the following pop-up window will appear:

1.Mass Storage:

Select "Mass Storage", and the computer will display the camera's memory card drive. You can transfer files from a removable disk to your computer.

2.PC Camera:

Select the "PC Camera", the camera can be used as a web-camera for real-time streaming and other media.

3.Charge:

Select the "Charge", the camera supports normal recording function.

13. About Camera:

System requirements users can transfer videos and photos to their computers through the following methodsto configure:
Intel Pentium 2.0GHz or higher/Microsoft Windows XP or higher operating system 2GB RAM or above 40GB available disk memory/standard USB interface/1GB GPU or higher 1920x1080 pixels or higher resolution.
