

How to use this product

Function operation

Power ON: Press and hold the **(a)** button for about 2 seconds when the headphones are off. The blue LED light will turn on and begin to alternate between blue and red.

Pairing: Activate the Bluetooth® function on your phone within range and select "anko43620791/anko43620807" from the list shown. When the LED light stops alternating blue and red, you will hear a voice prompt saying "the Bluetooth device is connected successfully", indicating the headphones have been successfully paired with your device. When playing music, the LED light will slowly flash blue.

Play/Pause: When music is playing, press the **1** button to pause it and then press **1** again to resume playing music.

Volume up: Turn the volume wheel clockwise to increase the volume.

Volume down: Turn the volume wheel anti-clockwise to decrease the volume.

Next song: Press the 🕀 button to play the next song.

Previous song: Press the Θ button to play the previous song.
