## IMPORTANT SAFETYGUARDS

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE

Please follow all the precautions listed below for safety and to reduce the risk of injury or electric shock.



**WARNING: READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS, FAILURE TO FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS LISTED BELOW MAY RESULT IN ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR SERIOUS PERSONAL INJURY.**

1. For hygienic reasons, do not share this appliance with other people.
  2. Only use the appliance as described in this manual.
  3. Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid, product is splash-proof only.
  4. Do not allow the appliance to be exposed to rain or moisture during use or storage.
  5. Always check the appliance for damage prior to use. If any damage is observed, do not use the appliance.
  6. The appliance is intended for indoor use only.
  7. Always switch the appliance off after use.
  8. This appliance has no user serviceable parts. Do not attempt to access the appliance covers.
  9. This appliance is for personal use only, not designed for commercial use.
  10. Do not use it outdoors.
  11. **Do not use** the appliance if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or if it has been immersed in any liquid.
  12. Before using the appliance, ensure that the rotary head is securely fitted.
  13. Do not use it on children or allow children to play with the appliance.
  14. The appliance is not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
  15. Children being supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
  16. Only charge the appliance with the USB cable that was supplied with the appliance.
  17. Only Charge the appliance with Extra Low Voltage Battery Charger (not supplied) with an output rating 5Vd.c. 1A, same as indicated on the appliance's rating label.
  18. When charging the appliance, make sure it is switched OFF.
  19. Check that your supply voltage is the same as that stated on the charger.
  20. When charging the appliance, the power switch must be OFF.
  21. Use only attachments provided.
  22. This product contains sharp blades, please take the utmost care in handling and use.
- CAUTION: To avoid personal injury, do not use the trimmer if it has a damaged blade.**
23. Do not use salt water or boiling water when cleaning. Also, do not use cleaning products that are designed for toilets, bathrooms or kitchen appliances.



**WARNING: Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.**



**WARNING: Before charging the product, please make sure your hands are dry.**



**WARNING: Only use the USB cable supplied with the appliance. Use of other cable may cause electrical failure and/or fire.**



## **WARNING**

Only use the USB cable that was supplied with this Appliance.

Consumers are cautioned against trying to replace the battery. Using and/or purchasing counterfeit and/or inferior quality batteries have the potential to cause fire, personal injury, and/or damage to property. These batteries are typically found on online-auction websites or from other retailers and are known to pose a potential safety risk.

Never try to charge non-rechargeable batteries as they may explode or catch on fire or cause personal injury and/or damage to property.

## CHARGING

**IMPORTANT:** This Appliance contains a built-in lithium-ion battery which must only be charged using the supplied USB cable.

**DO NOT allow to charge for more than 2 hours.**

**Normal charge takes approximately 1.5 hours.**

If any abnormality occurs during charging, (such as burning smell or excessive heat or even a strange sound) immediately turn off the charger and disconnect the USB cable.

**IMPORTANT: The Appliance must be fully charged before first use.**

- Take the USB Cable and fully unravel it before using it to charge the Appliance.
- Plug the small end of the USB cable directly into the bottom of the appliance.
- Plug the large end of the USB cable into your 5Vd.c. 1A USB charger (not supplied) and switch on.
- Whilst charging, the display will illuminate with percentage of charging level: 30%, 65%, 100%.
- When fully charged, unplug the USB charging cable from the appliance.

# OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



## WARNING:

Switch OFF the device before replacing or changing the attachments

### Installing the comb attachment

1. Make sure the trimmer is **switched off** before attaching the comb.
2. Set the **cut length** to the highest level.
3. Align the **comb rails** with the **slots** on the sides of the trimmer.
4. Gently **slide or clip** the comb attachment onto the main body as shown below.
5. Once fitted, you can **adjust the cut length** by turning the adjustment dial.



**NOTE:** Do not turn dial when the trimmer is switched ON.

### To remove the comb attachment

1. Make sure the trimmer is **switched off** before removing the comb.
2. Set the **cut length** to the **highest level**.
3. Gently **lift the back of the comb attachment upwards** to remove it from the trimmer.



## Installing the blade

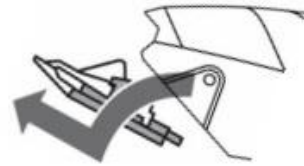
### CAUTION!

**Risk of injury!** Handle the trimmer improperly may result in injury.

The Blade assembly can be removed for deep cleaning.

### To remove the blade assembly

1. Hold the trimmer firmly.
2. Gently **press the blade assembly away** from the main unit — the blade assembly will **pop out**.



### To install the blade assembly

1. Align the **bottom of the blade** with the main unit.
2. Swing the blade into place and **press firmly** until it **clicks and locks** into position.



## Using the trimmer

1. Before trimming, **comb the hair** to remove any tangles and ensure it is **clean and dry**.
2. Attach the **comb attachment** and **adjust the length setting** to your desired trimming length.
3. Press the **power switch** to turn the trimmer **on**.
4. **Trim against the direction of hair growth**, keeping the flat part of the comb gently against the skin.
5. To avoid clogging, **remove and clean** the comb attachment regularly during use.
6. Press the **power switch** again to turn the trimmer **off**.

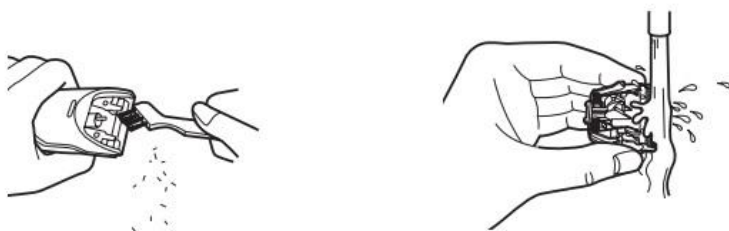
### Travel lock:

1. **To lock:** Press and hold the **power button** for **3 seconds**. The battery indicators will **flash three times** to confirm the trimmer is locked.
2. **To unlock:** Press and hold the **power button** again for **3 seconds**. The battery indicators will **flash three times**, unlocking the trimmer and turning it on.

## CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

**Caution! Blades are sharp. Please be careful when handling and cleaning!**

1. Make sure the appliance is disconnected from the USB cord and switched off.
2. Remove the comb attachment and blade.
3. Brush off any hair trimmings around the blade and main body.
4. Rinse off any hair trimmings that are sticking to the blades with running water.
5. Gently shake the cutting blade then wipe off the water.
