SUFFOCATION HAZARD

› BABIES YOUNGER THAN 9 MONTHS CAN SUFFOCATE IN THIS PRODUCT IF FACE IS PRESSED TIGHTLY AGAINST YOUR BODY. BABIES AT GREATEST RISK OF SUFFOCATION INCLUDE THOSE BORN PREMATURELY AND THOSE WITH RESPIRATORY PROBLEMS.

› CHECK OFTEN TO ENSURE BABY'S FACE IS UNCOVERED, CLEARLY VISIBLE, AND AWAY FROM CAREGIVER'S BODY AT ALL TIMES.

› ENSURE BABY DOES NOT CURL INTO A POSITION WITH THE CHIN ON OR NEAR BABY'S CHEST. THIS POSITION CAN INTERFERE WITH BREATHING, EVEN WHEN NOTHING IS COVERING THE NOSE OR MOUTH.

› IF YOU NURSE YOUR BABY IN THE CARRIER, ALWAYS REPOSITION AFTER FEEDING SO BABY'S FACE IS NOT PRESSED AGAINST YOUR BODY.

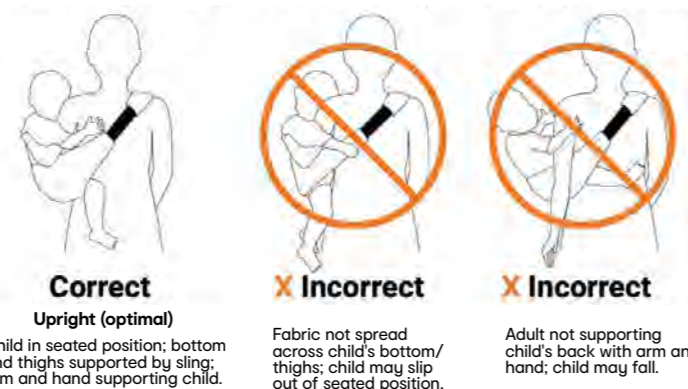
FALL HAZARD

› LEANING, BENDING OVER, OR TRIPPING CAN CAUSE BABY TO FALL. KEEP ONE HAND ON BABY AT ALL TIMES.

› ALWAYS HOLD YOUR CHILD WITH ONE ARM AND HAND.

› THIS CARRIER IS USED FOR SUPPORT ONLY.

› WHEN USING THIS CARRIER, CONSTANTLY MONITOR YOUR CHILD.



Correct

Upright (optimal)

Child in seated position; bottom and thighs supported by sling; arm and hand supporting child.

X Incorrect

Fabric not spread

across child's bottom/thighs; child may slip out of seated position.

X Incorrect

Adult not supporting

child's back with arm and hand; child may fall.

WARNING! TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH

› NEVER USE THE CARRIER WITH A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 9 MONTHS OR MORE THAN 20KG.

› NEVER USE THE CARRIER WITH A CHILD THAT CAN NOT SIT UP UNAIDED, LESS THAN 9 MONTHS OR MORE THAN 4 YEARS OLD.

› NEVER LEAVE CHILD UNATTENDED IN THE CARRIER.

› NEVER PLACE CARRIER ON COUNTERTOPS, TABLES, OR OTHER ELEVATED SURFACES.

› TAKE CARE WHEN BENDING AND LEANING FORWARD OR SIDEWAYS. ALWAYS BEND AT KNEES AND KEEP CHILD UPRIGHT TO AVOID FALLING AND TIPPING.

› CONSTANTLY MONITOR YOUR CHILD AND ENSURE THE MOUTH AND NOSE ARE UNOBSTRUCTED.

› FOR PRE-TERM, LOW BIRTHWEIGHT BABIES AND CHILDREN WITH MEDICAL CONDITIONS, SEEK ADVICE FROM A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT.

› ENSURE YOUR CHILD'S CHIN IS NOT RESTING ON ITS CHEST AS ITS BREATHING MAY BE RESTRICTED WHICH COULD LEAD TO SUFFOCATION.

› TO PREVENT ACTIVITY RELATED FALLING HAZARD, ENSURE YOUR CHILD IS SECURELY POSITIONED IN THE CARRIER.

› ONLY USE THE CARRIER WHEN WALKING, SITTING OR STANDING.

› NEVER USE THE CARRIER DURING SPORTS ACTIVITIES.

› NEVER USE WITH IMPAIRED BALANCE OR MOBILITY DUE TO EXERCISE, DROWSINESS, OR MEDICAL CONDITION.

› NEVER USE IN SHOWER, POOL, OR ANY OTHER LOCATION WHERE WATER IS PRESENT.

› NEVER USE WHILE ENGAGING IN ACTIVITIES SUCH AS COOKING OR CLEANING WHICH INVOLVE HEAT SOURCE OR EXPOSURE TO CHEMICALS.

› KEEP AWAY FROM FIRE.

› NEVER USE WHEN UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS.

› NEVER UTILISE THE CARRIER FOR TRANSPORTING YOUR CHILD IN A VEHICLE, ON A BIKE OR ANY SIMILAR MODE OF TRANSPORTATION.

› NEVER WEAR THE CARRIER WHILE DRIVING OR RIDING AS A PASSENGER IN A VEHICLE.

› NEVER ALLOW THE CHILD TO SLEEP IN THE CARRIER.

› CHECK FOR RIPPED SEAMS, TORN STRAPS OR FABRIC, AND DAMAGED HARDWARE BEFORE EACH USE. IF FOUND, STOP USING CARRIER.

› ALWAYS CHECK TO ENSURE THAT ALL KNOTS, BUCKLES, SNAPS, STRAPS, AND ADJUSTMENTS ARE SECURE.

› NEVER LEAVE A BABY IN A CARRIER THAT IS NOT BEING WORN.

› CHECK ON THE BABY OFTEN. ENSURE THAT THE BABY IS PERIODICALLY REPOSITIONED.

› NEVER USE/WEAR MORE THAN ONE CARRIER AT A TIME.

› NEVER PLACE MORE THAN ONE BABY IN THE CARRIER.

› CHECK ON YOUR CHILD OFTEN. BE AWARE YOUR CHILD MAY SUFFER FROM THE EFFECTS OF THE WEATHER AND SUN BEFORE YOU DO WHEN USING THE CARRIER. YOU MAY NEED TO PROVIDE WATER, SUNSCREEN OR A HAT.

› TAKE REGULAR BREAKS TO PREVENT THE CHILD FROM GETTING TIRED OR FEELING UNCOMFORTABLE IN THE CARRIER.

BEFORE USE

› ALWAYS INSPECT THE CARRIER BEFORE USE.

› CHECK FOR ANY RIPPED SEAMS, TORN STRAPS OR FABRIC, AND ANY DAMAGED HARDWARE.

› IF ANY OF THESE ISSUES ARE FOUND, DO NOT USE THE CARRIER.

› IF PREGNANT, CONSULT YOUR DOCTOR BEFORE USE.

ENSURE THAT THE CHILD IS SAFELY POSITIONED IN THE CARRIER ACCORDING TO THE INSTRUCTIONS IN THIS MANUAL.

WARNING!

WHEN USING THIS CARRIER, CONSTANTLY MONITOR YOUR CHILD.

INTENDED USE

THE TODDLER CARRIER IS SPECIFICALLY CRAFTED FOR THE SECURE AND ENJOYABLE TRANSPORT OF CHILDREN ON EITHER HIP, FOSTERING A DELIGHTFUL AND SNUG BONDING EXPERIENCE. ANY ALTERNATIVE USE OF THE CARRIER IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN AND MAY LEAD TO SEVERE INJURY OR DEATH.

THIS PRODUCT IS APPROVED FOR CHILDREN FROM 9 MONTHS UP TO APPROXIMATELY 4 YEARS OLD, WITH A WEIGHT OF 8-20 KG. DO NOT CARRY A CHILD THAT IS TOO YOUNG, AND ALWAYS CONSULT A PAEDIATRICIAN BEFORE TRANSPORTING A CHILD YOUNGER THAN 1 YEAR. CARRY ONLY CHILDREN THAT ARE ABLE TO SIT UP UNAIDED FOR A LONGER PERIOD OF TIME, AT LEAST AS LONG AS THE INTENDED JOURNEY REGARDLESS OF AGE, THE CHILD MUST BE ABLE TO HOLD ITS HEAD UP BY ITSELF. CHECK REGULARLY THAT THE CHILD DOES NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT.

› BE AWARE OF HAZARDS IN A DOMESTIC ENVIRONMENT E.G. HEAT SOURCES AND SPILLING OF HOT DRINKS. THIS CARRIER IS INTENDED TO BE USED WITH ONLY ONE CHILD AT A TIME.

› YOUR MOVEMENT AND THE CHILD'S MOVEMENT MAY AFFECT YOUR BALANCE.

ADDITIONAL

› GIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ANY SUPPORT REQUIRED UNTIL THE CHILD CAN SUPPORT ITS OWN HEAD.

› THE CARRIER IS NOT SUITABLE FOR USE DURING SPORTING ACTIVITIES E.G. RUNNING, CYCLING, SWIMMING AND SKIING.

› THE CAREGIVER SHOULD BE AWARE OF THE INCREASED RISK OF THE CHILD FALLING OUT OF THE CARRIER AS IT BECOMES MORE ACTIVE.

› ENSURE TO PERIODICALLY CHECK THAT THE CONNECTORS ARE SECURE AND THE CHILD IS SITTING COMFORTABLY AND SAFELY IN THE CARRIER.

› REGULARLY INSPECT THE CARRIER FOR ANY SIGNS OF WEAR AND DAMAGE.

› KEEP THE CARRIER AWAY FROM CHILDREN WHEN IT IS NOT IN USE.

STORAGE

SECURE THE BUCKLE AND FOLD IT INTO THE SEAT TO PREVENT LOOSE STRAPS.

HOW TO USE THE TODDLER CARRIER

› SECURE THE BUCKLE FIRST.

› ADJUST THE STRAP TO LOOSEN IT.

› SLIDE THE CARRIER OVER YOUR HEAD, ENSURING THE SHOULDER PAD RESTS ON EITHER YOUR LEFT OR RIGHT SHOULDER.

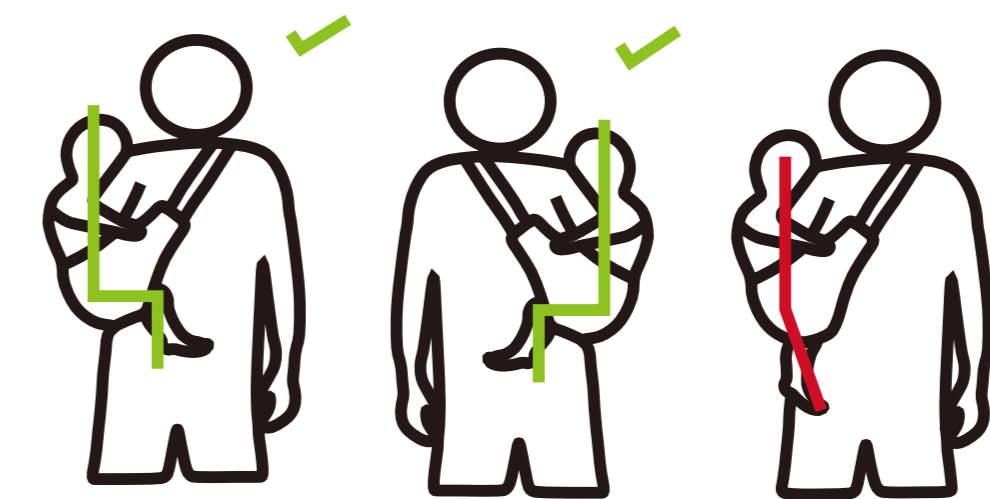
› POSITION THE SEAT ON YOUR LEFT OR RIGHT HIP.

› SEAT THE CHILD IN THE CARRIER, WITH ONE LEG AT THE FRONT OF YOUR BODY AND THE OTHER AT THE BACK.

› ADJUST THE STRAP SO YOUR CHILD CAN SIT CLOSELY TO YOUR BODY.

› SECURE THE BUCKLE USING THE ELASTIC LOOP.

› ENSURE YOUR TODDLER IS IN A SEATED POSITION WITH LEGS AT A 90-DEGREE ANGLE.



HOW TO REMOVE THE CHILD FROM THE CARRIER

› LOOSEN THE STRAP AND DISENGAGE THE BUCKLE, RELEASING TENSION.

› GENTLY LIFT THE CHILD FROM THE CARRIER, SUPPORTING THE CHILD WITH BOTH HANDS.

› CAREFULLY GUIDE THE CHILD'S LEGS OUT, ONE AT A TIME.

› ONCE THE CHILD IS SAFELY OUT OF THE CARRIER, LIFT THE CARRIER OFF YOUR SHOULDER.

ENSURE A SECURE AND GRADUAL REMOVAL TO PRIORITISE THE CHILD'S COMFORT AND SAFETY.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

TO EXTEND THE LIFE AND INTEGRITY OF THE PRODUCT, WE RECOMMEND HAND WASHING ONLY IN LUKEWARM WATER USING A MILD LIQUID DETERGENT.

DO NOT USE FABRIC SOFTENER.

DO NOT BLEACH.

LINE DRY IN SHADE.

DO NOT IRON.

DO NOT DRYCLEAN.
