


DIY Polymer Clay Magnet Kit Instruction Manual

Kit Includes


- > 10 x 10g coloured polymer clays
- > 1 x 28g coloured polymer clay
- > 4 x magnets
- > 2 x clay tools
- > 1 x clay roller
- > instructions



Guide Image



Place the brown strip around the edge of the toast to form the crust, and use your finger to smooth the ends together. Then, gently smooth the area where the toast and crust meet.




To make the fried egg, place the small yellow circle on top of the white circle and gently press to secure.



Place 2 dark brown eyes, 1 mouth, 2 pink cheeks and 1 fried egg on the toast and press them slightly to secure them into their positions. The toast is temporarily finished.

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How To Make A Polymer Clay Cake



Take some light pink clay and roll into a ball with your hands.




Use your fingers to mould a cylinder shape for the base of the cake.



Repeat steps 1-2 to make a second piece for the top of the cake.




Take some white clay and roll it into a ball with your hands. Use the roller to flatten it to a thickness of about 4mm to form the cream filling centre.



Take some white clay and roll into a ball with your hands. Use the roller to flatten it to a thickness of about 3mm. Then use the clay tool to cut a shape for the icing, as shown.

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
Take some white clay and roll it into a thin, string-like strip. Then take some dark brown clay and roll it into 2 string-like strips. The dark brown strip should be very thin and cut short to make the mouth. The other should be slightly thicker and cut into 2 short pieces to form the legs. Finally, cut the white strip into about 34 short pieces.



Place the piece of white icing on top of the pink top base and add the small white pieces around the side of the pink top base. Gently press to secure them in place.




Stack the top base from step 7 and the cream filling from step 4 on top of the pink bottom base. Gently press them together to secure in place.



Take a small amount of red clay and roll it into 6 balls with your hands. Use your fingers to mould them into strawberry shapes, then use the clay tool to create texture by lightly indenting the surface.

Join 1 dark brown leg piece with 1 foot, and gently press together to secure in place. Repeat this step to make 2 legs with feet.



Place 2 dark brown eyes and 1 mouth on the front of the bottom cake base. Arrange 6 small strawberries on top of the cake and 2 legs with feet underneath, as shown. Gently press them to secure them in place. The cake is temporarily finished.

How To Bake Polymer Clay Figurines



Preheat the oven to 140°C for 10 minutes. Place the figurines on an oven tray lined with baking paper and bake for 15 minutes. Baking time may vary depending on the clay thickness and your oven. Carefully remove the tray using an oven mitt and allow the figurines to cool before touching.



When the figurines have cooled and hardened, peel the backing paper off the magnets and firmly attach a magnet to the back centre of each figurine. Your foodie magnets are now ready to decorate your fridge or magnetic board.


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Tips

- > Wash your hands before beginning, and prepare a clean, smooth work surface.
- > Baking time may vary depending on your oven and the thickness of the clay. Take care to avoid burning it.
- > Use a protective mitt or similar to remove the tray from the oven. Do not touch the hot clay. Allow the clay to cool and harden on the tray.

How To Make A Polymer Clay Cupcake



Take some aquamarine clay and roll it into a ball with your hands.



Use your fingers to mould the shape of a cylinder.




Take some white clay, aquamarine clay, a small amount of light green clay, and dark brown clay. Roll each colour into thin, string-like strips. The dark brown strip should be very thin and cut into a short piece to form the mouth. The white and aquamarine strips should be thicker and longer.


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
Bend the aquamarine strip to form the handle of the cup. Coil the white clay strip to resemble piped icing, and gently press both pieces to secure them in place.




Take some red clay and roll it into a ball with your hands.



Take some light green clay and roll it into a ball with your hands. Use your fingers to mould it into the shape of a leaf, then use the clay tool to make a shallow indent down the centre of the leaf.



Join the red ball, light green strip and small leaf together, as shown. Gently press them to secure them in place.




Take a small amount of pink and a small amount of dark brown clay, roll each colour into 2 balls with your hands, then flatten them with your finger.




Place 2 dark brown eyes, 1 mouth, and 2 pink cheeks on the front of the cup. Then place the cherry on top of the icing as shown. Gently press them to secure them in place. The cupcake is temporarily finished.


How To Make A Polymer Clay Strawberry




Take some red clay and roll it into a ball with your hands.




Use your fingers to mould the shape of the strawberry's body.



Take some light green clay, roll it into a ball with your hands. Use the roller to flatten it to about 3mm thick. Use the clay tool to cut out the leaf shape and to make shallow indents on the leaves, as shown.




Place the leaves on top of the strawberry's body and gently press to secure it in place.



Take a small amount of light green clay and dark brown clay. Roll each colour into string-like strips. The dark brown strip should be very thin and cut into a short piece to form the mouth. The light green strip should be a bit thicker and longer.


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Take a small amount of pink and a small amount of dark brown clay, roll each colour into 2 balls with your hands, then flatten them with your finger.




Place 2 dark brown eyes, 1 mouth, 2 pink cheeks on the front of the strawberry. Gently press to secure them in place.




Use the clay tool to create a texture on the red body by indenting the surface. The strawberry is temporarily finished.

How To Make Polymer Clay Toast




Take some light brown clay and roll it into a ball with your hands.


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Use the roller to flatten the clay to about 5mm thick. Ensure the slab is large enough to cut a toast shape. Cut out the toast shape using the tool. The size should be approximately 5cm x 5cm.



Take a small piece of pink and a small piece of dark brown clay, and roll each colour into 2 balls with your hands. Flatten them with your finger. Then take some white and yellow clay, roll each colour into a ball, and press them into 2 flat circles.



Take some dark brown and brown clay and roll each colour into a string-like strip. The dark brown strip should be very thin and cut into a short piece to form the mouth. Cut the brown strip to match the length of the toast's outer edge to form the crust.

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
