## Safety Instructions

- 1) This product contains no user serviceable parts and do not attempt to repair the product yourself. Leave any servicing or repairs to qualified personnel only.
- 2) If the mounted device is over 5kg, the tripod may tip over, potentially damaging your device.
- 3) Always place the tripod on a flat and stable surface to prevent the mounted device from tipping over. When using outdoors, also be aware that extending the mount too high increases the risk of falling. Be particularly careful when using in windy conditions.
- 4) When changing the position of the tripod stand, please first remove the projector. Strong vibrations from such movement may cause damage to the 360 deg. rotation and the projector.
- 5) Do not leave the product near heat sources such as furnaces or heaters, or inside vehicles on hot days.
- 6) After use, can fold the tripod stand and put into the pouch to store.
- 7) This device is not a toy. Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the device.

## Instruction for Use

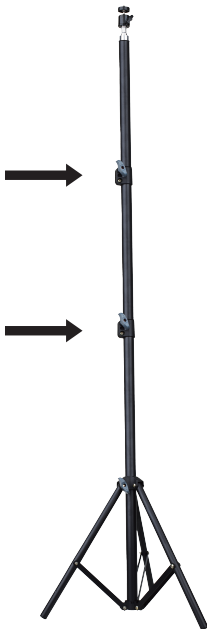
1. Remove the nut protective cover ④ from the tripod stand, align the 360 deg. rotation ② with the 1/4" screw hole on the tripod stand and tighten to lock it in place.



2. Unscrew the bottom rotary switch to unfold the tripod stand to place it on a flat surface, tighten the screw again.



3. Loosen the other two rotary switches to install the telescopic rod to the desired length, then tighten the screw.
