

## DIY Crochet Kit - Easter Chick

## Instructions

## Step 1. Body.

**Rnd 1.** With yellow yarn, form a magic ring, work 8 sc in ring, pull tail to close, join. (8 sts)

**Rnd 2.** Ch 1, [sc inc in next st] 8 times, join. (16 sts)

**Rnd 3.** Ch 1, [sc in next st, sc inc in next st] 8 times, join. (24 sts)

**Rnd 4.** Ch 1, [sc in next st, sc inc in next st, sc in next st] 8 times, join. (32 sts)

**Rnd 5.** Ch 1, sc in next 32 sts, join. (32 sts)

**Rnd 6.** Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sts, sc inc in next st] 8 times, join. (40 sts)

**Rnds 7-9.** Ch 1, sc in next 40 sts, join. (40 sts)

**Rnd 10.** Ch 1, [sc in next 2 sts, sc inc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 8 times, join. (48 sts)

**Rnds 11-13.** Ch 1, sc in next 48 sts, join. (48 sts)

**Rnd 14.** Ch 1, sc in next 11 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 22 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 11 sts, join. (46 sts)

**Rnd 15.** Ch 1, sc in next 46 sts, join. (46 sts)

**Rnd 16.** Ch 1, [sc in next 2 sts, sc inc in next st] 4 times, sc in next 3 sts, sc inc in next st, [sc in next 4 sts, sc inc in next st] 3 times, sc in next 3 sts, [sc inc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 4 times, join. (58 sts)

**Rnds 17-20.** sc in next 58 sts, join. (58 sts)

**Rnd 21.** Ch 1, [sc in next 4 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts] 3 times, sc in next 2 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts] 3 times, join. (48 sts)

**Rnd 22.** Ch 1, sc in next 48 sts, join. (48sts)

**Rnd 23.** Ch 1, [sc in next 2 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts] 8 times, join. (40 sts)

**Rnd 24.** Ch 1, sc in next 40 sts, join. (40 sts)

**Rnd 25.** Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts] 8 times, join. (32 sts)

**Rnd 26.** Ch 1, [sc in next st, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next st] 8 times, join. (24 sts)

Start filling with polyester stuffing.

**Rnd 27.** Ch 1, [sc in next st, sc dec in next 2 sts] 8 times, join. (16 sts)

**Rnd 28.** Ch 1, [sc dec in next 2 sts] 8 times, join. (16 sts)

Cut the yarn and close the hole.

## Step 2. Hat.

**Rnd 1.** With dark yellow yarn, form a magic ring, work 8 sc in ring, pull tail to close, join. (8 st)

**Rnd 2.** Ch 1, [sc inc in next st] 8 times, join. (16 st)

**Rnd 3.** Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sts, sc inc in next st] 4 times, join. (20 st)

**Rnd 4.** Ch 1, sc in next 20 sts, join. (20 st)

Change to white yarn.

**Rnd 5.** Ch 1, sc in next st, [2 hdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, [2 dc in next st] 2 times, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, [2 hdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in next st.

Sew in a suitable position on top of the body.

## Step 3. Wings. ( x 2 pieces)

**Rnd 1.** With yellow yarn, form a magic ring, work 6 sc in ring, pull tail to close, join. (6 sc)

**Rnd 2.** Ch 1, [sc in next st, sc inc in next st] 3 times, join. (9 sc)

**Rnds 3-5.** Ch 1, sc in next 9 sts, join. (9 sc)

Fill with a small amount of fibrefill stuffing.

**Rnd 6.** Ch 1, [sc in next st, sc dec in next 2 sts] 3 times, join. (6 sc)

Sew in a suitable position on both sides of the body between 13-14 rounds.

## Step 4 - Feet ( x 2 pieces)

With dark yellow yarn.

**Rnd 1.** Ch 4, from the second chain on the hook, sc in next st,

sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, sc in next st, sc in next st, join. (7 sts)

Sew in a suitable position on the body between rounds 18-21.

## Step 5 - Mouth

With dark yellow yarn.

Make a magic ring, work 2 sc, hdc, 2 sc in ring, pull tail to close, join.

The mouth is sewn between the 11-12 rounds of the body

## Step 6 - Eyes

With black yarn.

Eyes are sewn between Rnds 10-11, with 7 stitches between them.

Take 30cm black yarn, wrap the yarn around the needle 5 times.

Pull the needle through all 5 loops at once, then pull the resulting loop through the same stitch. If the shape is uneven, need to secure with the yarn in the second stitch.

## Materials included:

4 x coloured yarns  
1 x crochet hook  
1 x fibrefill stuffing  
1 x plastic needle  
2 x stitch markers

## Supplies required:


scissors

## Finished size:

Approximately: 9cm H x 8cm W x 11.5cm L

Note: Results may vary due to personal skill and tension used.

Knowledge of crochet is required.



## Read Before Beginning:

Do not change the size of the hook included.

Do not sew very tight, complete the project under normal strength to achieve a firm shape, and avoid stiff stitches.

Keep tension on the yarn to maintain even and compact stitches.

Practice stitching in single crochet before beginning this project to get a feel for the yarn and required hook size.

Pattern Notes: Join with a slip stitch in first single crochet unless otherwise stated. Begin each round in same stitch as joining.

## Abbreviations:

ch - chain stitch	mr - magic ring	inc - increase single crochet	sc - single crochet
dc - double crochet	flo - front loop only	yo - yarn over	sl st - slip stitch
dec - decrease single crochet	hdc - half double crochet	blo - back loop only	

[] - Repeat the directions in between [ and ] as many times as stated.

(-) - The number inside will indicate how many stitches you should have at the end of each round.

## How to change colour:

Insert hook into next stitch, yo hook and pull up a loop; with new color, yo and pull through both loops on hook. When changing colour at joining, insert hook into joining stitch, with new color, yo and pull through both loops on hook (sl st made). When changing color in hdc, yo hook and pull up a loop; with new color, yo and pull through all 3 loops on hook.


## When working in rounds:

Ch 1, work around in single crochet, joining each round with a sl st to the beginning sc. Pull tail to tighten beginning round, weave in tail from beginning ring after Rnd 3.

Keep track of where you are by placing a stitch marker in the first stitch of the current round.

## Chain stitch (ch):

Make a slip knot on hook:  
Yarn over (yo) and pull the yarn through the loop on the hook to form a new loop.



Be careful not to tighten loop.  
Repeat this step to form the number of chains specified.

## Yarn over (yo):

Wrap the yarn from back to front over the hook. Draw the yarn through to form a new loop.



## Magic ring (mr):

Yarn over, but don't pull loop tight. Ch 1 in loop. Do not tighten loop. Pull tail to form the center of chains specified.



## Slip stitch (sl st):

Yarn over, draw yarn through chain and the loops on sc hook in one motion (slip stitch made). To work a sl st in a row of stitches (sc stt), as shown, insert hook under the top 2 loops in one motion (slip, yarn over, draw through 2 loops in one motion).



## Increase single crochet (inc):

Two sc in each stitch.




## Back loop only (Blo):

Yarn over (yo), pull through loop on hook.




## Decrease single crochet (dec):

Also known as sc2tog. [Draw up a loop in next stitch] 2 times - 3 loops on hook - yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.



## Single crochet (sc):

Insert hook into the work (second chain from hook on starting chain) as shown. Yarn over hook and pull a loop through - 2 loops on hook. Yarn over hook again and draw through both loops on hook - single crochet made.




## Half double crochet (hdc):

Yarn over hook, insert hook into next stitch, yarn over hook and pull through, 3 loops on hook, yarn over hook and pull through all loops on hook - half double crochet made.



## Double crochet (dc):

Yarn over and insert the hook into the next chain or stitch. Yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over hook and pull through 2 loops on hook - double loop made.



## Front loop only (Flo):

Yarn over (yo), pull through loop on hook.
