## DIY Crochet Kit – Easter Rabbit Instructions

### Step 1. Body.

**Rnd 1.** With white yarn, form a magic ring, work 6 sc in ring, pull tail to close, join. (6 sc)

**Rnd 2.** Ch 1, (sc inc in next st) 6 times, join. (12 sc)

**Rnd 3.** Ch 1, (sc in next st, sc inc in next st) 6 times, join. (18 sc)

**Rnd 4.** Ch 1, (sc in next st, sc inc in next st, sc in next st) 6 times, join. (24 sc)

**Rnd 5.** Ch 1, (sc in next 3 sts, sc inc in next st) 6 times, join. (30 sc)

**Rnd 6.** Ch 1, (sc in next 2 sts, sc inc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (36 sc)

**Rnd 7.** Ch 1, (sc in next 5 sts, sc inc in next st) 6 times, join. (42 sc)

**Rnd 8.** Ch 1, sc in next 42 sts, join. (42 sc)

**Rnd 9.** Ch 1, (sc in next 3 sts, sc inc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) 6 times, join. (48 sc)

**Rnd 10.** Ch 1, sc in next 48 sts, join. (48 sc)

**Rnd 11.** Ch 1, (sc in next 7 sts, sc inc in next st) 6 times, join. (54 sc)

**Rnd 12.** Ch 1, sc in next 54 sts, join. (54 sc)

**Rnd 13.** Ch 1, (sc in next 4 sts, sc inc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) 6 times, join. (60 sc)

**Rnds 14–25.** Ch 1, sc in next 60 sts, join. (60 sc)

Embroider nose and mouth with pink yarn between Rnds 11–16.

**Rnd 26.** Ch 1, (sc in next 4 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts) 6 times, join. (54 sc)

**Rnd 27.** Ch 1, (sc in next 7 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (48 sc)

**Rnd 28.** Ch 1, (sc in next 3 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts) 6 times, join. (42 sc)

**Rnd 29.** Ch 1, (sc in next 5 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (36 sc)

**Rnd 30.** Ch 1, (sc in next 2 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (30 sc)

**Rnd 31.** Ch 1, (sc in next 3 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (24 sc)

**Rnd 32.** Ch 1, (sc in next st, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next st) 6 times, join. (18 sc)

**Rnd 33.** Ch 1, (sc in next st, sc dec in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (12 sc)

Fill with polyester stuffing.

**Rnd 34.** Ch 1, (sc dec in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (6 sc)

Slip stitch to finish and leave a long end for sewing.

### Step 2. Tail.

Rnd 1. With pink yarn, form a magic ring, work 6 sc in ring, pull tail to close, join. (6 sc)

Rnd 2. Ch 1, (sc inc in next st) 6 times, join. (12 sc)

Rnd 3. Ch 1, (sc in next st, sc inc in next st) 6 times, join. (18 sc)

Rnd 4. Ch 1, (sc in next st, sc dec in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (12 sc)

Fill with polyester stuffing.

Rnd 5. Ch 1, (sc dec in next 2 sts) 6 times, join. (6 sc)

Slip stitch to finish and leave a long end for sewing.

Sew to the center back of the body between Rnds 23–25.

### Step 3. Ears. ( x 2 pieces)

Rnd 1. With white yarn, form a magic ring, work 5 sc in ring, pull tail to close, join. (5 sc)

Rnd 2. Ch 1, (sc in next st, sc inc in next st) 2 times, sc in next st, join. (7 sc)

Rnd 3. Ch 1, (sc in next 2 sts, sc inc in next st) 2 times, sc in next st, join. (9 sc)

Rnds 4–8. Ch 1, sc in next 9 sts, join. (9 sc)

Rnd 9. Ch 1, (sc in next 2 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts) 2 times, sc in next st, join. (7 sc)

Slip stitch to finish and leave a long end for sewing.

### Step 4 – Inner ears (x 2 pieces)

Rnd 1. With pink yarn, ch 3, from the second chain on the hook, sc in next 2 sts. (2 sc)

Rnds 2–6. Ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 sts. (2 sc)

Rnd 7. Ch 1, turn, sc dec in next 2 sts. (1 sc)

Slip stitch to finish and leave a long end for sewing.

Sew onto white ears.

Sew the ears on the body at Rnds 3–6.


### Step 6 – Eyes

With black yarn.

Eyes are sewn between Rnds 11–12, with 7 stitches between them.

Take 30cm black yarn, wrap the yarn around the needle 5 times.

Pull the needle through all 5 loops at once, then pull the resulting loop through the same stitch. If the shape is uneven, need to secure with the yarn in the second stitch.

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## DIY Crochet Kit – Easter Rabbit Instruction manual

### Materials included:

3 x coloured yarns  
1 x crochet hook  
1 x fibrefill stuffing  
1 x plastic needle  
2 x stitch markers

### Supplies required:

scissors

### Finished size:

Approximately: 14cm H x 10.5cm W x 9cm L  
Note: Results may vary due to personal skill and tension used.  
Knowledge of crochet is required.



## Read Before Beginning:

- Do not change the size of the hook included.
- Do not sew very tight, complete the project under normal strength to achieve a firm shape, and avoid stiff stitches.
- Keep tension on the yarn to maintain even and compact stitches.
- Practice stitching in single crochet before beginning this project to get a feel for the yarn and required hook size.
- Pattern Notes: Join with a slip stitch in first single crochet unless otherwise stated. Begin each round in same stitch as joining.

### Abbreviations:

<b>ch</b> – chain stitch	<b>mr</b> – magic ring	<b>inc</b> – increase single crochet	<b>sc</b> – single crochet
<b>dc</b> – double crochet	<b>flo</b> – front loop only	<b>yo</b> – yarn over	<b>sl st</b> – slip stitch
<b>dec</b> – decrease single crochet	<b>hdc</b> – half double crochet	<b>blo</b> – back loop only	

- [ ] – Repeat the directions in between [ and ] as many times as stated.
- () – The number inside will indicate how many stitches you should have at the end of each round.

### How to change colour:


Insert hook into next stitch, yo hook and pull up a loop; with new color, yo and pull through both loops on hook. When changing colour at joining, insert hook into joining stitch, with new color, yo and pull through both loops on hook (sl st made). When changing color in hdc, yo hook and pull up a loop; with new color, yo and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

### When working in rounds:

- Ch 1, work around in single crochet, joining each round with a sl st to the beginning sc. Pull tail to tighten beginning round, weave in tail from beginning ring after Rnd 3.
- Keep track of where you are by placing a stitch marker in the first stitch of the current round.


### Chain stitch (ch):

Make a slip knot on hook:  
Yarn over (yo) and pull the yarn through the loop on the hook to form a new loop.  
Be careful not to tighten loop.  
Repeat this step to form the number of chains specified.




### Yarn over (yo):

Wrap the yarn from back to front over the hook. Draw the yarn through to form a new loop.



### Magic ring (mr):

Yarn over, but don't pull loop tight. Ch 1 in loop. Do not tighten loop. Repeat to form the number of chains specified. Pull yarn tail to draw the center of the ring tightly closed.




### Slip stitch (sl st):

Yarn over, draw yarn through chain and the loop on your hook in one motion (slip stitch made). To work a slip stitch in a row of stitches (sc stitches shown), insert hook under the top 2 loops of the next stitch, yarn over, draw yarn through stitch and the loop on your hook in one motion (slip stitch made).




### Increase single crochet (inc):

Two sc in each stitch.



### Back loop only (Blo):

Yarn over (yo), pull through loop on hook.




### Decrease single crochet (dec):

Also known as sc2tog. [Draw up a loop in next stitch] 2 times – 3 loops on hook – yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.



### Single crochet (sc):

Insert hook into the work (second chain from hook on starting chain) as shown. Yarn over hook and pull a loop through – 2 loops on hook. Yarn over hook again and draw through both loops on hook – single crochet made.




### Half double crochet (hdc):

Yarn over hook, insert hook into next stitch, yarn over hook and pull through, 3 loops on hook, yarn over hook and pull through all loops on hook – half double crochet made.



### Double crochet (dc):

Yarn over and insert the hook into the suggested space, chain or stitch. Yarn over and draw yarn through pulling up a loop. Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull yarn through next 2 loops on hook – double crochet made.



### Front loop only (Flo):

Yarn over (yo), pull through loop on hook.
