Keep your eyes on the road and pull over if you need to adjust settings.



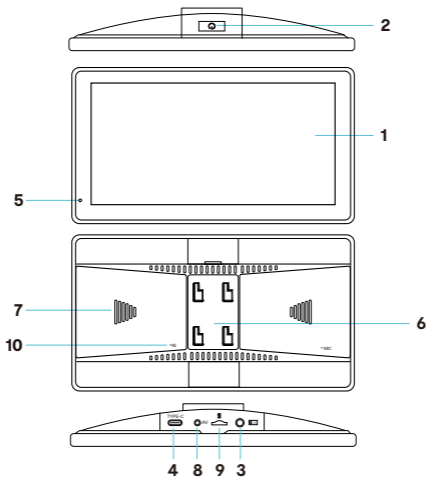
1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Supervise children using the product. It is not a toy.

8. AV Input: Use to connect a compatible rear view camera (Not supplied with this model).

9. TF Card Slot (Not included).

10. Reset Button for restart the device: press and hold using a SIM eject tool (not included).

5. POWER CONNECTION

- Only use the supplied 12/24V power adaptor to power the device.
- Once the device is securely installed on the windscreen or dashboard, plug the 12/24V power adaptor into the vehicle's 12/24V power port.
- Run the cable along the vehicle's dashboard and plug the USB-C connector into the device.

5.1. AUTO POWER ON/OFF

When the device is correctly installed and connected to the 12/24V power port, it will automatically power up when the vehicle ignition is turned on.

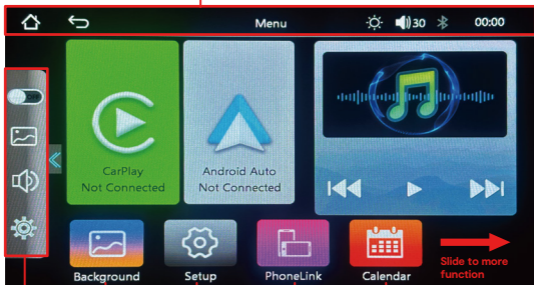
The Device is designed to be powered only by the supplied Power Adaptor.

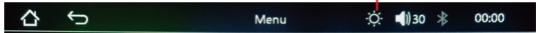

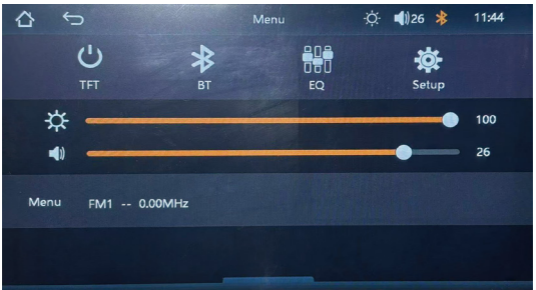
15. Top function box (simple show and swipe down to expand for more features)

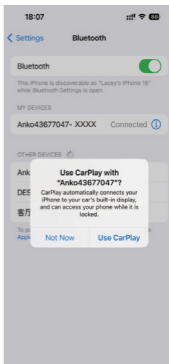
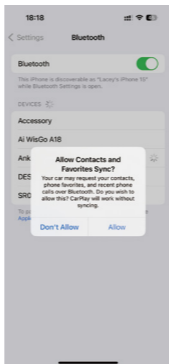
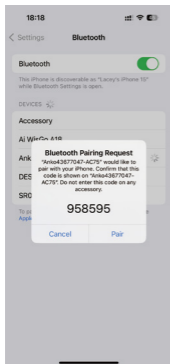
6.1 APPLE CARPLAY

FIRST-TIME CONNECTION

Click the Apple Carplay icon, find the Bluetooth name Anko43677047-XXXX (XXXX being unique number), turn on Bluetooth connection and Wi-Fi on your phone and select to pair Bluetooth successfully.



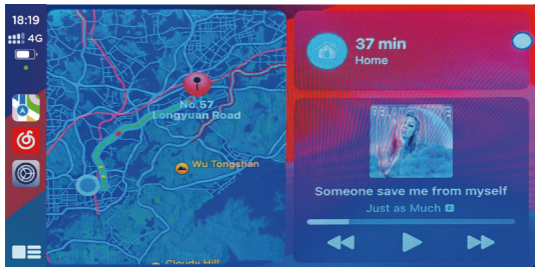
1. Bluetooth Pairing Request: check the random pin code on your iPhone, please select "pair".
2. Allow Contacts and Favorites Sync: Please select "Allow".
3. Use Carplay with "Anko43677047-XXXX": After connected the Bluetooth will pop-up it on your phone, please select "Use Carplay".



After the first connection, it will show "Connected" and display the Apple CarPlay menu.

NOTE:

1. Choose "■■■■" and then choose "HOME" on the Apple carplay menu to back the home dashboard of the main car play device.
2. Anko43677047-XXXX and your iPhone will pair automatically each time the car play device is powered on when your iPhone is in close proximity.
3. Connecting for the first time will take slightly longer. Only compatible with iOS 13.0 or higher.



6.2 ANDROID AUTO

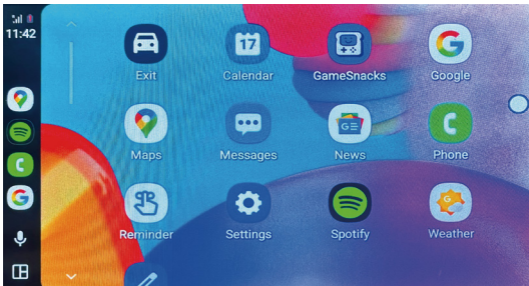
FIRST-TIME CONNECTION

Click the Android Auto icon, find the Bluetooth name Anko43677047-XXXX (XXXX being unique number), turn on Bluetooth connection and Wi-Fi on your phone and select to pair Bluetooth successfully.



"Pair with Anko43677047-XXXX": check the random pin code on your Android phone, please select "pair".

"Allow access to messages?" : please select "Allow".




NOTE:

1. Choose "EXIT" on the Android Auto menu to back the home dashboard of the main car play device.
2. Anko43677047-XXXX and your Android Phone will pair automatically each time the car play device is powered on when your Android Phone is in close proximity.
3. Connecting for the first time will take slightly longer. Only compatible with Android 11.0 or higher.


7. Audio Output

To improve the sound experience, it's recommended to change the sound output to Car Audio or other speaker by AUX cable or head-phone after connected the Bluetooth or FM or TF card.




 Audio will be output by the local speakers.



 Please use your phone to connect to your car Bluetooth.

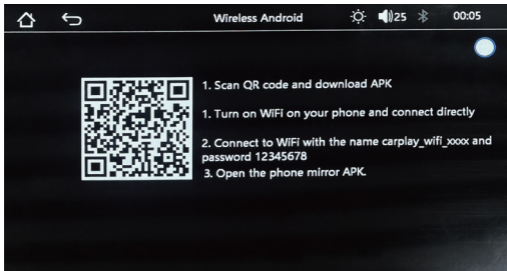
 Please turn on the FM of your car and set it to the same frequency band as this unit.



Please use the AUX cable to connect this unit to your car or other speakers.

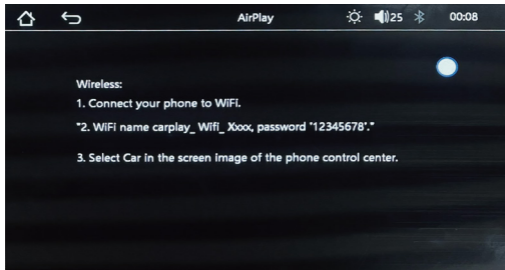
8. ANDROID MIRROR

Click the Android Mirror icon to show the connecting instructions. After the first connection, the phone's interface can be mirrored onto the car play device.



9. AIRPLAY

Click the Airplay icon to show the connecting instructions. After the first connection, the phone's interface can be mirrored onto the car play device.



10. FM TRANSMITTER

1. Audio Output—FM transmitter.

2. Left side function box (Folded and touch to unfold) — On/Off logo. The car play has built-in speaker, but if you want loudersound, you can transfer it to your vehicle's speakers by FM.

When you turn on the FM Transmitter, the car play device will be muted. You will need to match the frequency of the Car player to a free frequency channel on your vehicle's radio (please avoid using the channel to be occupied by the FM station).

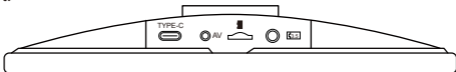

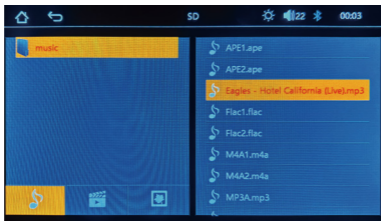
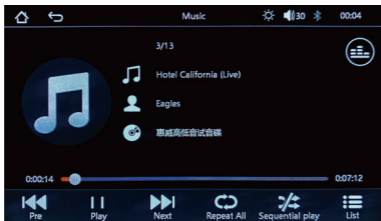
When playing music via Bluetooth or TF card, also please turn off the FM function. Otherwise the speaker will not produce any sound.

11. TF CARD MEDIA FILE

1. The TF Card can be used to store movies and music, which can be played once the TF card (Not included) is inserted into the TF Card slot.



2. Once inserted correctly, the music interface will display and play music directly.



3. Clicking the "↶" will return you to the Media File interface to access music and video files on your TF Card.

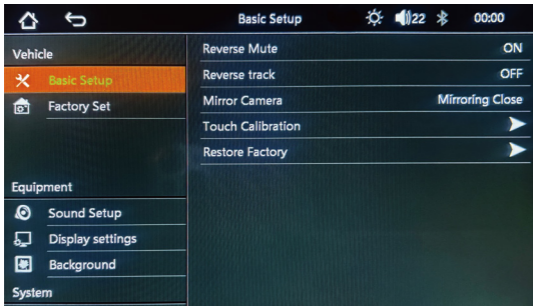

12. SETTINGS

Click the right icon to the interface of Settings.





13. Trouble shooting

1. The FM transmitter has poor signal and noise interference.

Answer: If the FM transmission signal is poor, you need to fix the car radio and plugin the antenna, and organize the wiring harness to avoid interference in the frequency band.

2. Wireless car play often disconnects or doesn't work.

Answer: When connecting to the car play device, do not connect the phone to other wireless networks to avoid the car play disconnection. You can cut off the power supply or press the Reset Button to restart the product.

3. The bracket is not strong, the suction cup adhesion is not enough, and the adhesion is unstable under high temperature.

Answer: When sticking, pay attention to keep the sticky position clean and dry to avoid the occurrence of bubbles and unstable stickiness when sticking.

4. The Bluetooth is out of sync, the caller can't hear the sound or there is noise.

Answer: Make sure that the mic position is not blocked by foreign objects.
