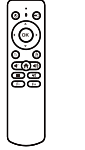
Warning

7. If you won't be using the projector for a long time, please turn it off and cut off the power supply. Charge it once every three months to extend the battery life.
8. To ensure the machine operates normally, it is recommended to clean the dust after a period of use. Tools such as a cleaning stick or cotton swab can be used for this purpose.
9. If projector defected, do not attempt to repair it by yourself. Please contact with your distributor or factory directly.
10. To avoid risk of electronic shock, do not disassemble or repair the device. Incorrect repair may cause risk of electronic shock or injury to people during operating.

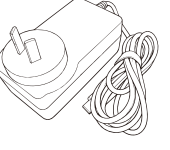
Battery Warning:

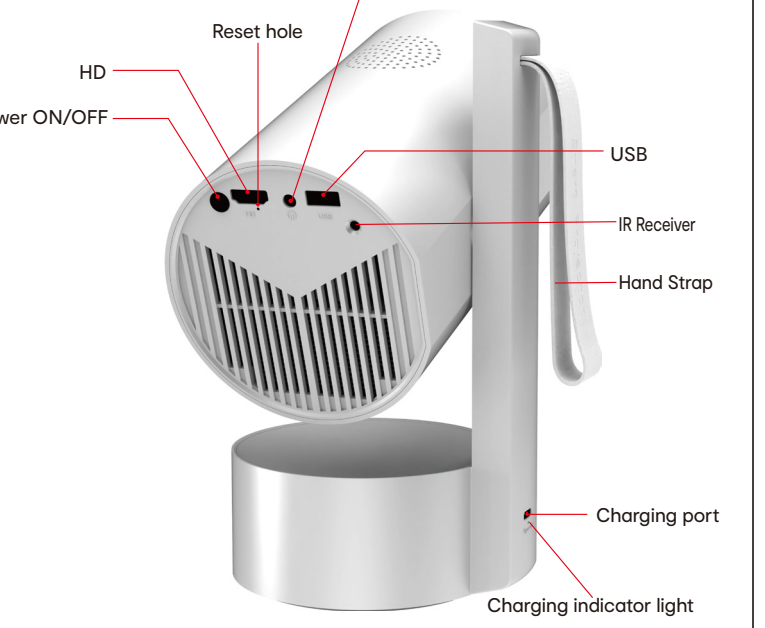

Product Overview

Power ON/OFF: long press to turn on/off the projector.
Charging port: the charging indicator light is always on when charging and off when fully charged.

Reset hole: Card needle insertion hole to reset the projector.
If the machine is unresponsive or is running slowly due to insufficient storage space, you can use the reset function.
(Please note: the reset function will delete all data stored on the machine; please ensure you save any necessary data before using this function).

Installation

Choosing a location

Before choosing an installation location for your projector, take the following factors into consideration:
> Size and position of your screen
> Electrical outlet location
> Location and distance between the projector and the rest of your equipment.

You can install your projector in the following ways

1. Front Desktop:

Select this location with the projector placed near the floor in front of the screen. This is the most common way to position the projector for quick setup and portability. Turn on the projector and make the following settings:
Settings >Projection Setting >Projection Mode >Rotate Front



2. Front Ceiling:

Select this location with the projector suspended from the ceiling in front of the screen. Turn on the projector and make the following settings:
Settings >Projection Setting >Projection Mode >Rotate ceiling

Note: A projector mount is required to install the projector in a ceiling.



Operation

Starting up the projector

1. Plug the power cable into the projector and a power outlet. The charging indicator light will be white when charging.

Please use the supplied power cable to avoid possible dangers such as electric shock and fire.

2. Press the power button on the projector or remote control to start the projector. The fans start operating, and a start-up image is displayed on the screen while it warms up. The projector does not respond to further commands while it is warming up.
3. When using for the first time, users must set an initial 6-digit password (which set by themselves and need remember).

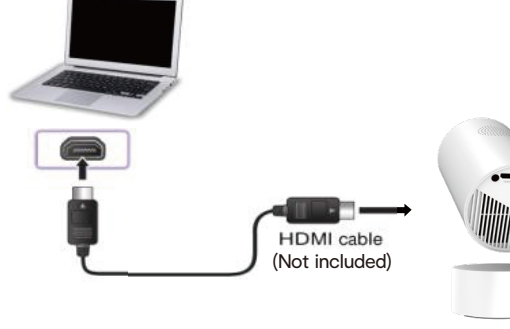

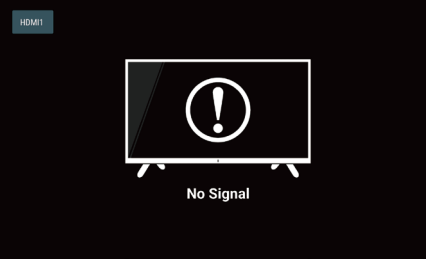
Connecting HD Devices

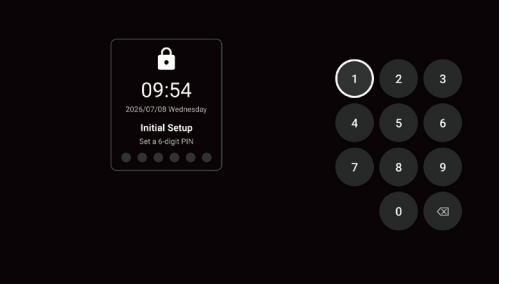
HD signal

Plugging in an HD cable allows you to access computer and other devices.

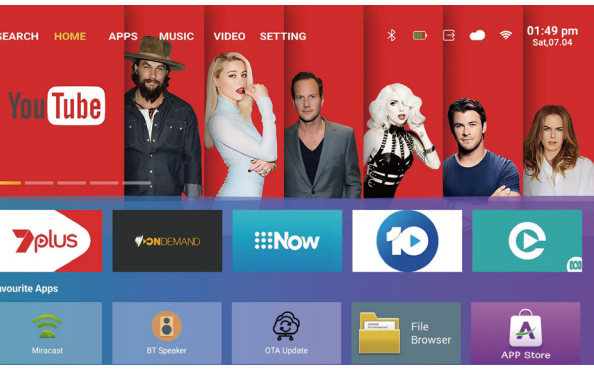


Password setup

If forgets their password, they may enter the factory master password 951753, then reset the password, verify it and log in to the system.

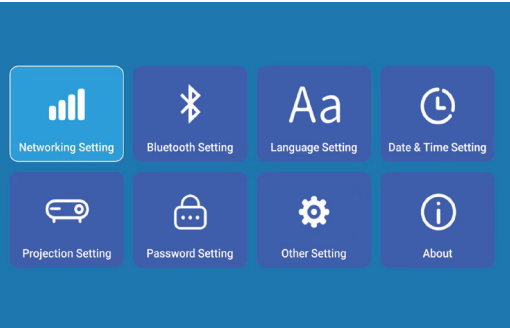

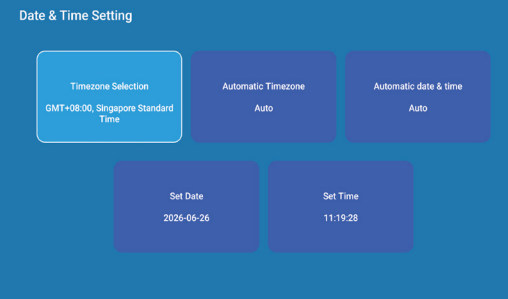

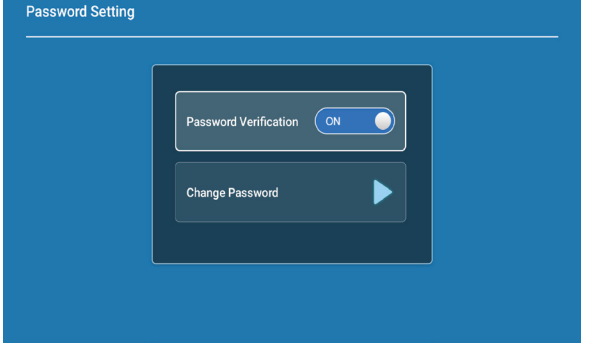
Data & Time setting

The default setting is auto timezone and date & Time, also can set date and time by manual.

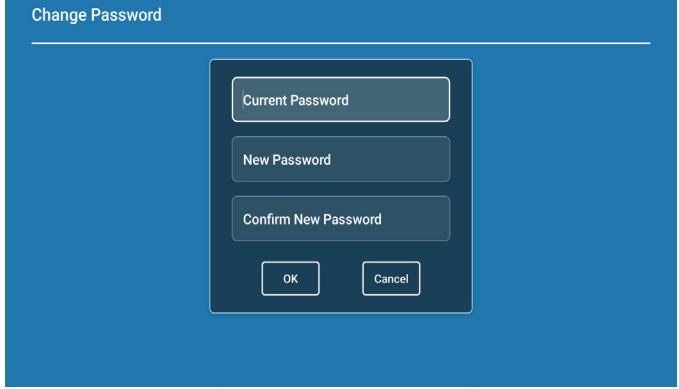

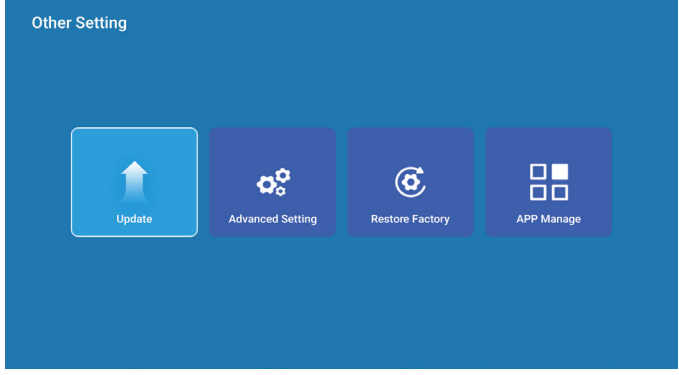
The user can turn on/off password verification in Password Setting. If you remember the initial password and want to change the password, you can click "Change Password" to set a new password.

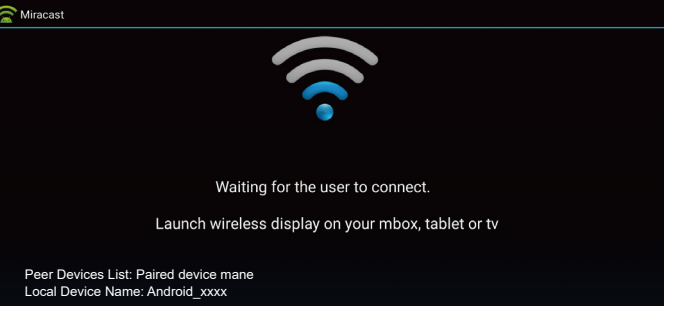

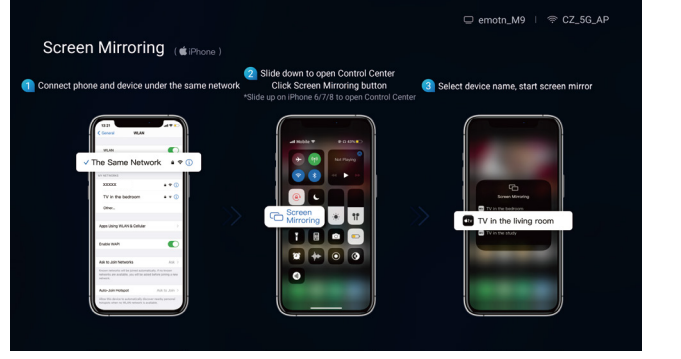
Screen Mirroring

Miracast: turn on the screen mirror of android device and make sure that your android device is connected to the same network as the projector.



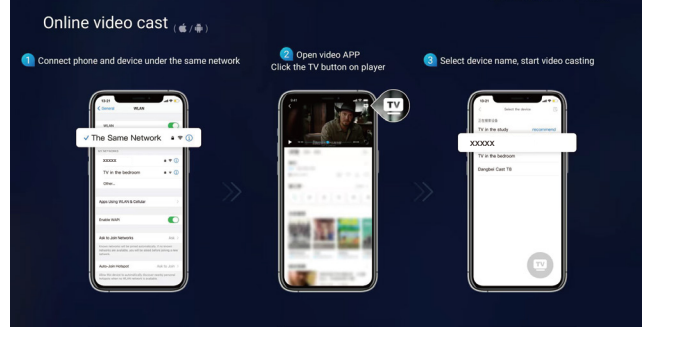

1.Screen mirroring: turn on the screen mirror of iOS device and make sure that your iOS device is connected to the same network as the projector.



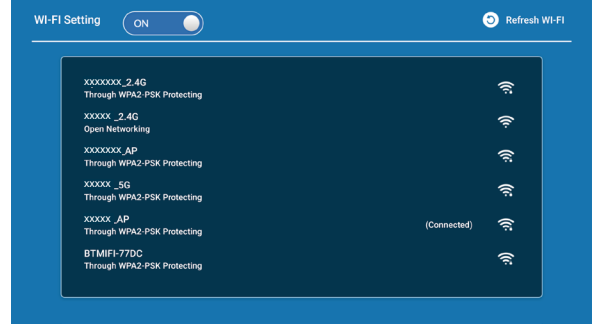

The user first connects to the wifi or sets the hotspot, and can watch the video online after connecting to the network.



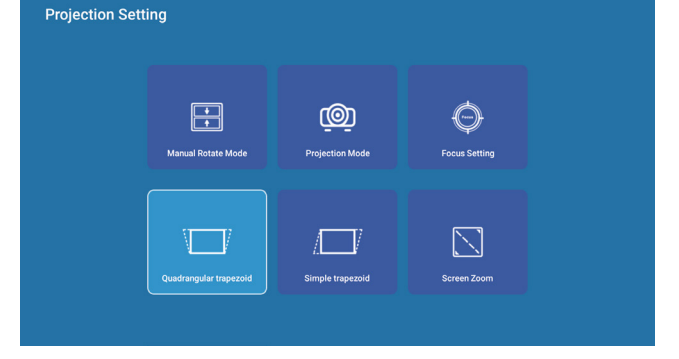
Bluetooth Setting

Connect Bluetooth devices, Bluetooth phones, Bluetooth speakers etc.



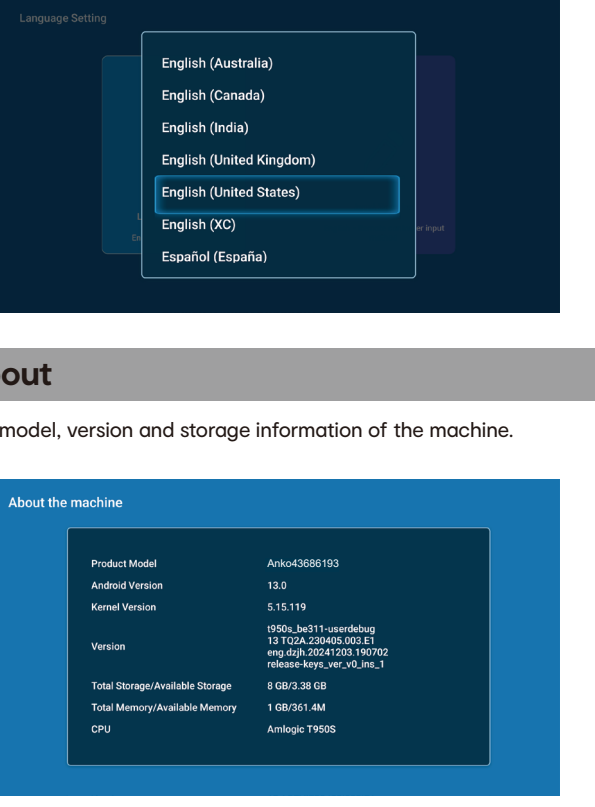

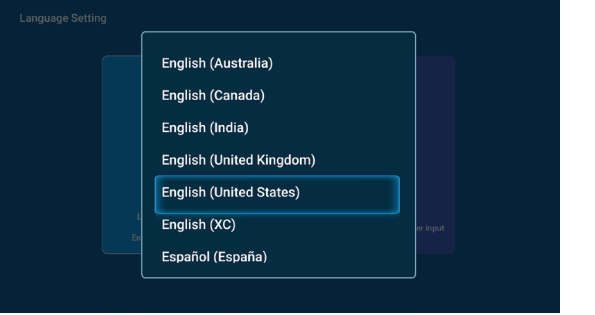

Trouble Shooting

- Remote control not working?
Make sure the batteries are effective and installed in the correct way.

- Blurry image?
Use manual focus to get the best image
The quality of the projection screen will also affect the image quality. Recommended to use it on a white wall or a better quality screen. Not suggest to use it on a thin white gauze screen, which will reduce the image quality.

- No Sound?
Ensure the Mute button has not been pressed.

- Automatic shut-down?
The unit will shut down if it overheats. Please ensure it is used in a ventilated environment.
The bottom of the projector has a air inlet, please ensure it is not blocked.
It is recommended to unplug the power supply after use to prolong the service life.

- Upside down image?
Please enter "Projection Mode" to select the corresponding mode.

- Video can not be mirrored or cast?
Due to copyright restrictions, some videos cannot be mirrored or projected.
The cast function only supports the built-in APP application of the projector.

- Black spot on the screen?
Wipe the lens with dry and clean cloth to remove dust on the lens.

- The APP cannot be used?
It might be that the old version of the app is no longer usable after the upgrade.
Please uninstall it from the App Store and then download and reinstall it.

- Forgot password cannot login?
Resetting the projector to reset the password.
If forget your password, can enter 951753 to reset your password and then access the main interface.

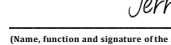
