


DIY Mosaic Coaster Craft Kit Instruction Manual

- › 2 x wooden coaster bases
- › 1 x grout
- › 6 x bags of mosaic tiles
- › 2 x double sides adhesive tapes
- › 1 x sponge
- › 1 x wooden stick
- › 1 x scraper
- › 1 x mixing bowl




Tips

- › Protect your work surface and clothing before beginning.
- › Keep the gaps between each tile approx. 1 - 2mm.
- › Attach the tiles to both coasters before mixing the grout.
- › Ensure the grout is completely dry before using the mosaic coasters.

How To Make A Mosaic Coaster




1 Peel off the paper from one side of the double-sided adhesive sheet. Apply it directly to the design side of the wooden coaster and press down firmly. Then peel the paper off from the other side of the adhesive sheet, leaving only the sticky surface exposed.




2 Begin laying the mosaic tiles over the design until all the tiles have been positioned. Make sure to press the tiles firmly in place as you go. Use the guide image as a reference.




3 Pour the grout into the mixing bowl. Gradually add water while stirring until it forms a smooth, paste-like texture. One bag of grout requires approx. 40 ml of water.



4 Using the scraper, apply the grout to cover the tiles completely. Spread it evenly to fill all the gaps, then scrape off any excess grout from the surface of the tiles.



5 Wet the sponge with water and gently clean the tiles in a circular motion until the top surface is clear of grout, leaving the grout only in the gaps. Allow approx. 5 hours for the grout to dry.



6 Clean off any remaining grout. Then the mosaic coaster is complete and ready to use.
