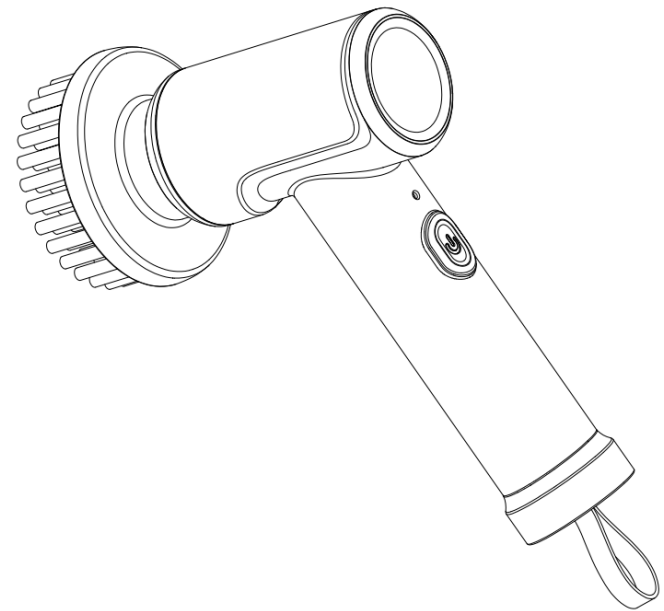

Warnings

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE

Please follow all the precautions listed below for safety and to reduce the risk of injury or electric shock

WARNING: Charge the angled scrubber **only** with a power charger approved for use in Australia and New Zealand, rated at **5V d.c., 1A**. Using an unapproved charger may cause damage or create a safety risk.

- This product should not be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Do not install, charge or use this product outdoors, in the bathroom or around the swimming pool.
- To prevent fire, explosion or injury, please check the lithium battery and USB cable for any damage before use. Do not use the product if the lithium battery or USB cable is damaged.
- Please check the area to be cleaned before use. If you find large paper, paper balls, plastic sheets or sharp objects, such as glass, nails, bolts, coins, etc., please remove them in advance.
- Do not place the product on an unstable surface such as a chair or table to prevent it from falling and to prevent injury or damage to the product.
- Only charge at the charging temperature of 5°C to 40°C. Charging in strict accordance with the instructions in the manual, charging outside the specified temperature range, may cause battery damage.
- Do not immerse the main unit or live parts in water or other liquids when cleaning.
- When cleaning and maintaining the product, please turn off the unit first and remove the brush head to prevent personal injury from the rotating brush head.
- Under extreme conditions and exposure to high temperatures, the battery may leak. If the skin is accidentally exposed to leaked battery liquid, please rinse immediately with clean water. If the liquid spills

into the eyes, in addition to flushing with water, please seek immediate medical attention.

- Unplug and make sure the scrubber is turned off after use and when storing.
- Do not attempt to remove the attachment head from the product when product is operating. Only attach or detach the brush head when product is turned off and at a full stop.
- Only use the accessories supplied with the product.
- For domestic use only. The product is not designed for commercial or Industrial use.
- For cleaning, please refer to section "Cleaning and Maintenance".



WARNING: Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.



WARNING: Before charging the product, please make sure your hands are dry.



WARNING: Only use the USB charging cable supplied with the product. Use of other cables may cause electrical failure and/or fire.



WARNING: To prevent overheating, battery damage or fire, only use a certified charger rated at 5V DC 1A with USB cable supplied with the product.

Only use the USB cable supplied with the Appliance.

Product contains a non-replaceable battery: 3.7Vd.c. 2000mAh Li-ion

- Do not use or store in temperatures above 40°C.



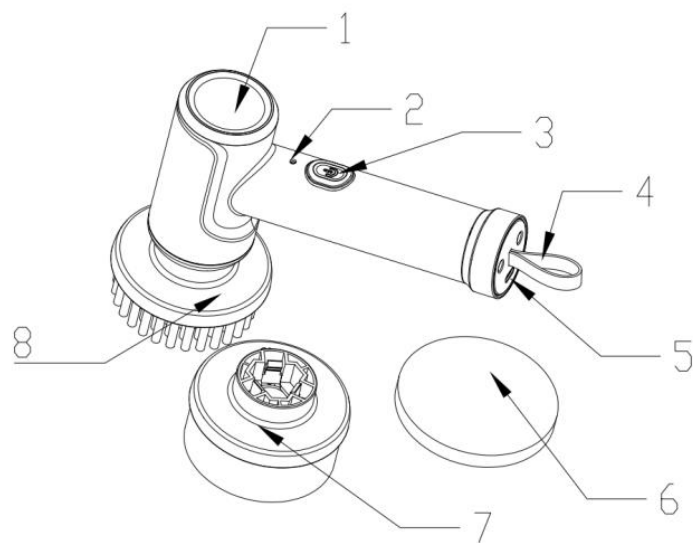

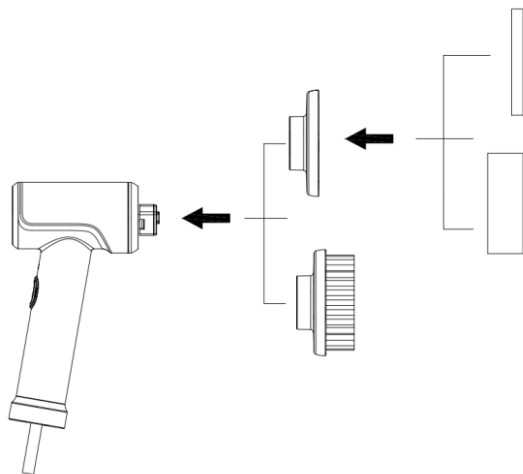


- 1.Main body

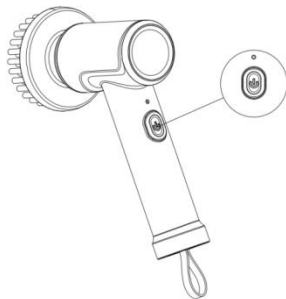
How to Use

Installing the brush head



Product Use

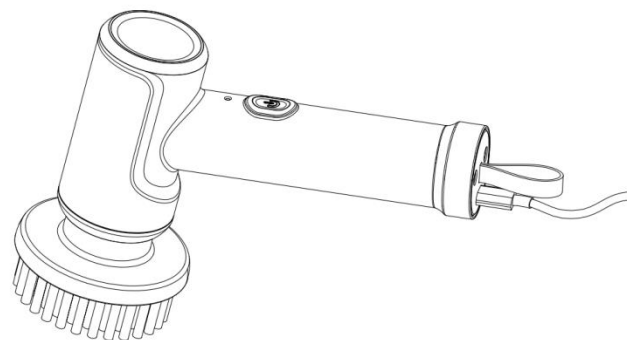
- During installation, please ensure that the brush is in the non-charging state or off state. Remove the Type-C charging cable before use.
- If the brush is charging or the battery is low, the brush will not work.
- Press the ON/OFF button, the Indicator lamp shows blue for high speed and green for low speed.



Charging

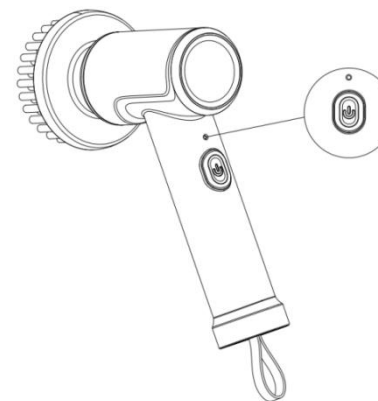
Note:

- The angled scrubber does not work when charging.
- Plug in the Type-C charging cable to charge the angled scrubber as shown in the figure below.



Power indicator status description

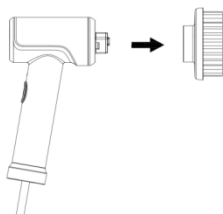
- Steady red light: The battery is charging.
- Steady green light: The battery is fully charged.



Cleaning and Maintenance

Tip: For better cleaning performance, it is recommended to remove the brush head for cleaning after use.

1. Turn OFF the product and wait for the product to stop completely.
2. Pull out the attached brush head, scouring pad or sponge brush head.



3. Rinse the brush head, scouring pad, sponge brush head under cold running water from the tap until it is clean. Dry thoroughly before reattaching to the main unit.

Common Problem

Problem	Possible Reason	Remedy
The product doesn't work	The power in the battery pack is low.	Recharge the battery pack.
	The ON/OFF button is not pressed.	Press the ON/OFF button.
Use time becomes shorter	The ambient temperature is too high or too low.	Use in a suitable environment.
	Battery is not fully charged.	Fully recharge the battery.
