Deluxe 300 Piece Poker Chip Set

Instructions

Contents:

- 300 Professional Dual-Toned Chips
- 2 Decks of Playing Cards

(Only one deck is needed for standard gameplay, the second deck can be used as a spare. Only the 52 standard cards are used in the game, remove the Jokers before playing.)

- 1 Dealer Button
- 5 Game Dice
- 1 Carry Case

Object:

Each player aims to create the highest-ranking five-card hand using a combination of personal cards and shared cards. At the end of each round, the player with the strongest hand wins the chips placed in the centre of the table.

Setup:

- The game is played over a series of rounds.
- After each round, pass the “Dealer” button clockwise to the next player.
- Before starting, the dealer distributes an equal number of chips of the same colour to each player.
- Players should agree on standard chip amounts to be placed during each round.
- Early rounds use the minimum agreed chip amount; later rounds may use a higher agreed amount.

Game Play:

1. Determine the first dealer using any agreed method (for example, rolling the dice). Place the “Dealer” button in front of that player.
2. Before dealing, players place an agreed starting amount of chips into the centre of the table as game points.
3. The dealer shuffles one deck and deals two cards face down to each player in a clockwise order.
4. In clockwise order, players may place chips into the centre of the table, match the current chip amount, or discard their cards.
5. The dealer places three shared cards face up in the centre of the table.
6. Players may again place chips or match the current amount in clockwise order.
7. The dealer places a fourth shared card face up.
8. A further chip placement round takes place.
9. The dealer places a fifth shared card face up.
10. A final chip placement round occurs.

Winner Determination:

- Each remaining player forms the best possible five-card hand using their cards and the shared cards.
- The player with the highest-ranking hand wins the chips from the centre of the table.
- In the event of a tie, the chips are divided equally among the tied players.

Alternate Play:

FREE CHIP MODE: Players may place any number of chips during their turn, up to the total number they hold.

Hand Rankings (From Highest to Lowest):

- Straight Flush (five consecutive cards of the same suit)
- Four of a Kind
- Full House (three of a kind and one pair)
- Flush (five cards of the same suit)
- Straight (five consecutive cards-Aces may be used before a two or after a King)
- Three of a Kind
- Two Pairs
- One Pair
- High Card (Ace, King, Queen, Jack, 10, 9, 8, etc.)
