# Happy Bunny Loom & Knit Kit

6+ years



## Hat

- Tie a knot in the yarn as shown.
- Pass the yarn through one peg of the round knitting loom.
- Wrap the yarn once around each peg of the knitting loom in sequence, as shown.
- When wrapping around the first peg again, pull the yarn end tight.
- Use the hook to lift the lower loop upward and off the peg, as shown at point A.
- Continue wrapping the yarn onto the next peg and repeat Step 4 and 5. Continue knitting until the length reaches approximately 5 cm, then stop.
- Thread the other end of the yarn through the plastic needle.
- As shown, pass the yarn through the loops below each peg.

- Remove the knitted piece from the loom and hold it firmly.
- Pull the yarn end to tighten the opening until it is fully closed.
- Use the plastic needle to thread the yarn through the center opening, then tie a knot to secure it.
- The main body of the hat is now complete.

## Pom-Pom

- Wrap the yarn around the butterfly-shaped tool.
- Wrap the yarn around the tool a few times, just as shown.
- Thread one end of the yarn through the plastic needle.
- Use the plastic needle to pass the yarn through the center of the wrapped yarn and wind it once around the middle.
- Pull the yarn tightly and tie a firm knot, then remove the yarn from the butterfly tool.
- Use scissors (not included) to cut both ends of the yarn.
- Thread one end of the yarn through the plastic needle.
- Thread the yarn through the corresponding position at the top of the hat.
- Tie a knot to secure.
- Repeat the above steps to complete one pom-pom.

## Clothing

- Tie a knot in the yarn as shown.
- Pass the yarn through one peg of the round knitting loom.
- Wrap the yarn once around each peg of the knitting loom in sequence, as shown.
- When wrapping around the first peg again, pull the yarn end tight. Use the hook to lift the yarn upward and off the peg, as shown at point A.
- Repeat Step 4. When the knitted length reaches approximately 5 cm, thread the other end of the yarn through the plastic needle.
- As shown, pass the yarn through the loops below each peg.
- Remove the completed knitted piece from the loom.
- Tie the yarn end into a knot. The clothing piece is now complete.

## Scarf

- Tie a knot in the yarn as shown.
- Thread the yarn through the center hole and secure it onto one peg of the knitting loom.
- Wrap the yarn once around four pegs on the knitting loom as shown.
- At the fourth peg, when the yarn overlaps with the yarn from the first peg, firmly hold the yarn end. Use the hook tool to lift the lower yarn upward so it slips off the peg.

anko

- Repeat Step 4 and continue knitting until approximately 20 cm of length is achieved. Thread a plastic needle onto the other end of the yarn.
- As shown, pass the yarn under the loops on each peg in sequence.
- Remove the completed knitted piece from the knitting loom.
- The scarf is now complete.

Put the completed knitted clothing onto the toy.

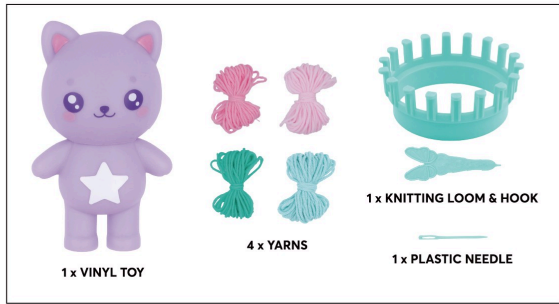

## Hat

# Sweet Bear Loom & Knit Kit

## Hat

- Tie a knot in the yarn as shown.

- When wrapping around the first peg again, pull the yarn end tight. Use the hook to lift the yarn upward and off the peg, as shown at point A.
- Repeat Step 4. When the knitted length reaches approximately 5 cm, thread the other end of the yarn through the plastic needle.
- As shown, pass the yarn through the loops below each peg.
- Remove the completed knitted piece from the loom.
- Tie the yarn end into a knot. The clothing piece is now complete.

## Apron

- Tie a knot in the yarn as shown.
- Place the round knitting loom onto one of the pegs.
- As shown, wrap the yarn once around 6 pegs on the knitting loom.
- On the 6th peg, overlap the yarn with the yarn on the 5th peg, then use the crochet hook to lift the lower A yarn over the peg.

anko

- Repeat Step 4. Knit until the length reaches approximately 3 cm. Thread the other end of the yarn through the plastic needle.
- As shown, pass the yarn under the loops on each peg in sequence.
- Remove the finished knitted piece from the knitting loom, using a crochet hook.
- The apron is now complete.
