The Steel Tongue Drum is a percussion instrument designed to produce soothing, melodic tones when struck with mallets or fingers.

Production structure:



1. Steel Tong Drum
2. Storage Bag
3. Drum Mallets

Important Safety Information

- This product is not a toy. Adult supervision is recommended when used by children. Use only as intended.
- Place the drum on a stable, flat surface during use.
- Avoid dropping or striking the drum excessively, as this may damage the surface or affect tuning.
- Store in a dry environment to prevent rust or corrosion.
- Do not expose to excessive moisture.

Operating instruction

1. Placement

Place the Steel Tongue Drum on a flat, stable surface in front of you.

Ensure the logo is facing towards you for correct note orientation.

You may also hold the drum comfortably on your lap while seated.

2. Holding the Mallets

Hold each mallet lightly between your thumb and index finger.

Maintain a relaxed grip to allow natural rebound when striking.

Avoid gripping too tightly, as this may affect sound quality.

3. Playing Technique

Gently tap the center area of each tongue using the mallets.

Use light, controlled movements to produce clear and resonant tones.

Do not strike the drum with excessive force, as this may result in harsh sound and potential damage.

4. Finger Playing (Optional)

The drum can also be played using your fingertips.

Lightly tap the tongues to create softer, more subtle tones.

Follow the numbered note markings on the drum surface to play the included sample melodies.
