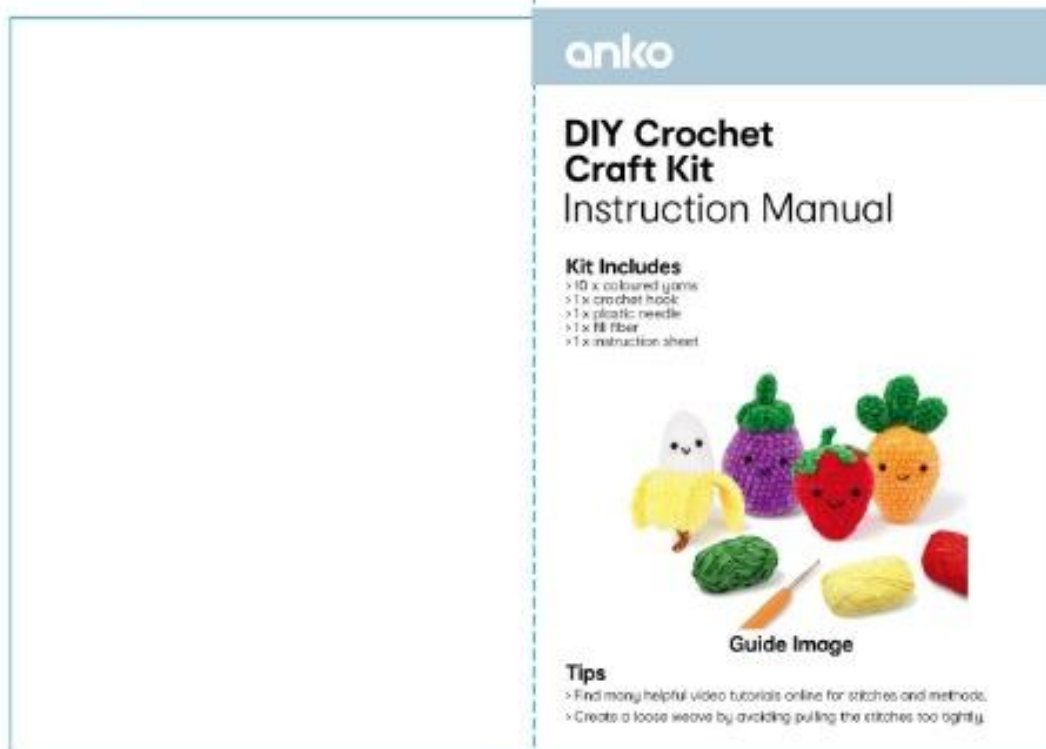

2.2. Leaf - Small Leaf

R1: 6 dc in magic ring (6 sts)
 R2: 6 dc inc (12 sts)
 R3-R4: 12 dc (12 sts)
 R5: (1 dc, dc2tog, dc) x 3 times (9 sts)
 R6: 9 dc (9 sts)
 R7: (1 dc, dc2tog) x 3 times (6 sts)
 Leave a long tail to sew and F/O. Stuff till firm halfway.
 After finishing R7, sew the hole. About sewing the hole: insert in each F/O of R7, then tighten it.



3. Sew

Sew the leaves onto the top of the body.



4. Face

Mouth: Take 2 strands of black yarn and sew the mouth.
 Eyes: Insert the needle in the appropriate stitch. Wrap the black yarn around the needle 2-3 times, then pull through the loops. Tidy the loops, then insert into the same stitch to form an eye. Repeat on the other side.

4. Double Crochet (Abbreviated 'dc')

Make a foundation chain to the required length. If you just want to practise, start by making about 20 chains. If you want to make a piece exactly 20 stitches wide, chain 21. Identify the second chain from your hook and then insert your hook here. Yarn over, then draw up a loop; you will now have 2 loops on your hook. Yarn over and then draw the yarn through both loops on the hook so you have 1 loop left on your hook. You have completed the stitch.



5. Double Crochet Two Stitches Together (Abbreviated 'dc2tog')

Insert your hook into the next stitch, as if to make a double crochet. Pull through a loop. Without completing the stitch, insert your hook into the next stitch as if to make another double crochet. Pull through a loop. You should now have 3 loops on your hook. Yarn over and draw the loop through all 3 loops on your hook. Having worked into 2 stitches but only created 1, you have decreased by 1.



6. Slip Stitch (Abbreviated 'sl st or ss')

Make a foundation chain to the required length. For a precise number of stitches, chain that many plus an extra 1. Identify the second chain from your hook, insert your hook into the second chain from the hook and yarn over. Pull your hook back through the chain; there should be 2 loops on your hook. Avoiding the urge to yarn over, continue to pull the yarn through the second loop on the hook - you have completed the stitch and should have 1 loop on your hook. Repeat steps 2-4 to finish the row.

3. Sew

Sew the leaf onto the narrower end of the body.



4. Face

Mouth: Take 2 strands of black yarn and sew the mouth.

Eyes: Insert the needle in the appropriate stitch. Wrap the black yarn around the needle 2-3 times, then pull through the loops. Tidy the loops, then insert into the same stitch to form an eye. Repeat on the other side.

10. Slip Knot

Crochet projects most commonly start with a slip knot. Create a loop about 15cm into your yarn. Insert your hook into the loop and pull the end attached to the yarn ball through the loop, then pull it tight. You now have a slip knot on your hook. Now you're ready to start crocheting.



11. Fasten Off (Abbreviated 'F/O')

Once you've worked your last stitch, you'll have 1 loop left on your hook. Cut the yarn leaving a tail approx. 15cm long. Wrap the yarn round the hook and pull through the loop. Remove the hook and pull the yarn tail to tighten it up. This will create a little knot that will mean your yarn can't unravel.



12. Weave in Ends

On the wrong side of your crochet, weave the needle in and out down the back of a few stitches as shown in the picture. Weave the needle back going in an upwards direction. There are no strict rules about how best to weave in the ends of yarn - the important thing is that they need to be secure and invisible from the front.

5. Sew

Sew the stem onto the bottom.



6. Face

Mouth: Take 2 strands of black yarn and sew the mouth.

Eyes: Insert the needle in the appropriate stitch. Wrap the black yarn around the needle 2-3 times, then pull through the loops. Tidy the loops, then insert into the same stitch to form an eye. Repeat on the other side.



How To Make An Eggplant

1. Body

R1: 6 dc in magic ring (6 sts)

R2: 6 dc inc (12 sts)

R3: 12 dc (12 sts)

R4: (3 dc, dc inc) x 6 times (18 sts)

R5: 18 dc (18 sts)

2. Leaf

R1: 6 dc in magic ring (6 sts)

R2: (ch 6, dc in 2nd ch from hook, 4 dc st st in next sp) x 6 times

Leave a long tail to sew and F/O.

Stem: Make a slip knot, ch 4, dc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 dc, ch 1 to secure.

Leave a long tail to sew and F/O. Sew the stem to the leaf.



3. Sew

Sew the leaf to the top of the body.

Basic Crochet Stitch Diagram

1. Magic Ring

Loop yarn around with working yarn on top. Insert crochet hook into loop. Hook working yarn. Pull working yarn through loop. Pull yarn up. You now have 1 loop on the hook. Yarn over and pull the yarn through the loop on hook to chain 1.



2. Chain Stitch (Abbreviated 'ch')

The chain stitch is the base for all crochet which is also called a foundation chain. The first step is to create a slip knot on your hook. The second step is to move your hook under your yarn to create a yarn over. The third step is to move the hook back through the loop already on your hook, making sure to catch the working yarn. You have now made your first chain. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make more chains. Hold the stitches you've already made in your left hand close to the hook for stability.



3. Double Crochet Increase (Abbreviated 'dc inc')

Make 1 double crochet into the stitch where you'd like the increase. Then a second double crochet is worked into the same stitch. To do this, insert the hook into the stitch (or chain space), yarn over and pull a loop through. Yarn over the hook again and pull through the 2 loops already on your hook to complete the second double crochet.

Cheeks: Sew 2 tiny cheeks under each eye, as shown.

7. Front Loop Only (Abbreviated 'FLO')

You work the stitch as normal, except that you insert your hook in only the front loop of the V, as shown below.



8. Back Loop Only (Abbreviated 'BLO')

You work the stitch as normal, except that you insert your hook in only the back loop of the V, as shown below.



9. Double Treble Crochet (Abbreviated 'dtr')

Make a foundation chain to the required length, making sure to chain 3 more than the number of stitches you need. Identify the fifth chain from the hook. Make 2 yarn overs and then insert your hook into the fifth chain from the hook. Yarn over and pull through a loop; there should be 4 loops on your hook. Yarn over, then pull the yarn through 2 of the loops on your hook. There should now be 3 loops on your hook. Yarn over, then pull the yarn through 2 of the loops on your hook again. There should now be 2 loops on your hook. Yarn over, then draw the yarn through the 2 loops on your hook. There should now be 1 loop on your hook.

How To Make A Carrot

1. Body

R1: 6 dc in magic ring (6 sts)
R2: 6 dc inc (12 sts)
R3: (dc, dc inc) x 6 times (18 sts)
R4: 18 dc (18 sts)
R5: (dc, dc inc, dc) x 6 times (24 sts)
R6: 24 dc (24 sts)
R7: (3 dc, dc inc) x 6 times (30 sts)
R8: 30 dc (30 sts)
R9: 12 dc, dc inc, 2 dc x 6 times (36 sts)
R10-R12: 36 dc (36 sts)
R14: (2 dc, dc2tog, 2 dc) x 6 times (30 sts)
R15: (3 dc, dc2tog) x 6 times (24 sts)
R16: (dc, dc2tog, dc) x 6 times (18 sts)
R17: (dc, dc2tog) x 6 times (12 sts)
R18: 6 dc2tog (6 sts)

Leave a long tail to sew and F/O. Stuff fill fore halfway. After finishing R18, sew the hole. About sewing the hole, insert in each FLO of R18, then tighten it.



2.1. Leaf - Big Leaf

R1: 6 dc in magic ring (6 sts)
R2: 6 dc inc (12 sts)
R3-R5: 12 dc (12 sts)
R7: (dc, dc2tog, dc) x 3 times (9 sts)
R8: 9 dc (9 sts)

R9: (dc, dc2tog) x 3 times (6 sts)
Leave a long tail to sew and F/O. Stuff fill fore halfway. After finishing R9, sew the hole. About sewing the hole, insert in each FLO of R9, then tighten it.

5-st cluster: Work 5 unfinished dc into the same stitch. You will have 6 loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through all loops.

How To Make A Strawberry

1. Body

R1: 6 dc in magic ring (6 sts)
R2: (dc, dc inc) x 2 times (9 sts)
R3: (dc, dc inc) x 4 times (12 sts)
R4: 12 dc (12 sts)
R5: (dc, dc inc) x 6 times (18 sts)
R6: 18 dc (18 sts)
R7: (dc, dc inc, dc) x 6 times (24 sts)
R8: 24 dc (24 sts)
R9: (3 dc, dc inc) x 6 times (30 sts)
R10: Rtn 30 dc (30 sts)
R11: (3 dc, dc2tog) x 6 times (24 sts)
R12: (dc, dc2tog, dc) x 6 times (18 sts)
R13: (dc, dc2tog) x 6 times (12 sts)
R14: 6 dc2tog (6 sts)
R15: 6 dc2tog (6 sts)

Leave a long tail to sew and F/O. Stuff it like halfway.
After finishing R15, sew the hole. About sewing the hole, insert in each FLO of R15, then tighten it.

R6: (dc, dc inc, dc) x 6 times (24 sts)
R7: 24 dc (24 sts)
R8: (3 dc, dc inc) x 6 times (30 sts)
R9: 30 dc (30 sts)
R10: (2 dc, dc inc, 2 dc) x 6 times (36 sts)
R11-R15: 36 dc (36 sts)
R16: (2 dc, dc2tog, 2 dc) x 6 times (30 sts)
R17: (3 dc, dc2tog) x 6 times (24 sts)
R18: (dc, dc2tog, dc) x 6 times (18 sts)
R19: (dc, dc2tog) x 6 times (12 sts)
R20: 6 dc2tog (6 sts)

Leave a long tail to sew and F/O. Stuff it like halfway.
After finishing R20, sew the hole. About sewing the hole, insert in each FLO of R20, then tighten it.



2. Leaf

R1: 5 dc in magic ring (5 sts)
R2-R4: 5 dc (5 sts)
R5: FLO 5 dc into (10 sts)
R6: join 4, 5-st cluster in next st, ch 4, sl st in next st x 6 times
Leave a long tail to sew and F/O.

4. Face

Mouth: Take 2 strands of black yarn and sew the mouth.
Eyes: Insert the needle in the appropriate stitch. Wrap the black yarn around the needle 2-3 times, then pull through the loops. Tidy the loops, then insert into the same stitch to form an eye. Repeat on the other side to create the other eye.



How To Make A Banana

1. Bottom Peel

R1: 6 dc in magic ring (6 sts)
 R2: 6 dc inc (12 sts)
 R3: (dc, dc inc) x 6 times (18 sts)
 R4-R6: 18 dc (18 sts)
 Work 1 st at to end R6 and ch 1 to start the top peel.



2. Top Peel x 3

Note: The 3 top peels are made in the same way, only the insertion points differ.
 Insert the 1st peel into the 1st st of R6 (FLO) of the bottom peel.
 Insert the 2nd peel into the 7th st of R6 (FLO) of the bottom peel.
 Insert the 3rd peel into the 13th st of R6 (FLO) of the bottom peel.

R7(FLO of R6 of bottom peel): 5 dc (5 sts)
 Ch 1, turn

R2-R6: 5 dc (5 sts)
 Ch 1, turn on the end of each row.
 R7: Dc2tog, dc, dc2tog (3 sts)
 Ch 1, turn.
 R8: Dc, dc2tog (2 sts)
 Ch 1, turn.
 R9: Dc2tog (1 st)
 Ch 1 to secure. Leave a long tail to sew and F/O.



3. Body

Note: The body starts in the BLO of R8 of bottom peel.

R1(BLO of R8 of bottom peel): (2 dc, dc2tog, 2 dc) x 3 times (15 sts)
 R2-R5: 15 dc (15 sts)
 R6: (dc, dc2tog) x 5 times (10 sts)
 R7: 5 dc2tog (5 sts)
 Leave a long tail to sew and F/O. Stuff the fibre halfway.
 After finishing R7, sew the hole. About sewing the hole, insert in each FLO of R7, then tighten it.



4. Stem

R1: Make a slip knot and ch 5, dc in 2nd ch from hook, 3 dc (4 sts)
 Ch 1 to secure. Leave a long tail to sew and F/O.
