READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE.

Please read this instruction manual before using your product and keep it in a safe place for future reference. If you pass the appliance on to anyone else, please include this manual.

- Carefully read all instructions before operation and retain for future reference.
- Do not place near the edge of a bench or table during operation.
- Ensure the surface is dry, level, clean and free of liquid and other substances.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended when in use. Always ensure the appliance is turned off by switching off and unplugging the appliance when not in use, if left unattended and before cleaning and storing.
- Always keep the appliance clean.
- Fully unwind the cord before use.
- To protect against electric shock, do not immerse the power cord, plug or appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Do not allow the cord to hang over the edge of the table or bench, touch hot surfaces or become knotted.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with this appliance.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a qualified electrician in order to avoid a hazard, or the product must be disposed of.
- This product is intended for household use only. Do not use it outdoors or use for commercial purposes.
- NEVER grasp the appliance, power cable or power plug with wet hands.
- Always remove the power cable from the socket by pulling on the plug, do not pull on the cable itself. Do not carry or lift the appliance with the power cord.
- Do not fold or crush the power cable. Ensure that the power cable does not run over sharp edges.

- Ensure the appliance concentrator nozzle is free to blockages. Unrestricted airflow is required for correct operation and to prevent overheating.
- The concentrator nozzle will become hot is use. Allow it to cool before removing it.

- For what action to be taken to adjust the appliance, please refer to section “SETTING THE MAINS VOLTAGE”

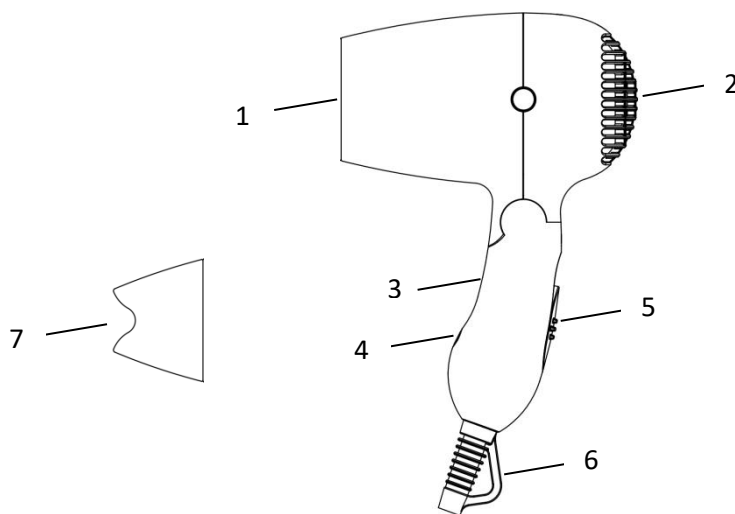

BEFORE FIRST USE

- After unpacking the appliance, check for transport damage and that all the parts mentioned in this manual are present. In the event of damaged or missing parts, return the product to respective Customer Service Centre.
- Do not discard the original box. It can be used for storage and dispatch to avoid transport damage.
- Clean the appliance as described in CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE. For your safety make particular attention to the IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS supplied in the user manual.
- **For Australia the Voltage Selector (4) must be set to 220-240V AC.**

SETTING THE MAINS VOLTAGE

Always check the local mains voltage in your area **before** connecting this appliance. You may need to change the voltage selector setting to match the local mains voltage correctly. To change the operating voltage, turn the selector switch on the handle with a screwdriver or a small coin to line up the slot in the screw with the correct voltage as shown below:



IMPORTANT! Always remember to check the voltage setting before use when you have travelled to another country or returned home. Incorrect voltage setting will result in permanent damage to the appliance

For Australia, ensure that the Voltage Selector (4) is set to 220-240V AC.

OPERATION

WARNING! To prevent hair from getting sucked in from the rear air vent, keep hair 10cm away from the hair dryer. Please ensure children are supervised when using the hair dryer.

- Fully unwind the mains cable. Make sure the Power/ Speed switch (5) is in OFF (0) position.
- Place the appliance on a smooth, flat, dry surface. Plug-in and switch on at the mains supply.
- Fit the Concentrator if required by pressing it firmly into the Air Outlet.
- The Concentrator can be dis-assembled if not required, but allow it to cool before removing.
- Adjust to the desired blowing strength:
Position O ----- OFF
Position  ----- Low heat setting
Position  ----- High heat setting
- When finished drying or styling, switch the appliance OFF, unplug the appliance and allow it to cool before putting it down/storing.

CLEAN THE REAR GRILLE

- If during use, the rear grille becomes clogged or blocked with dust or dirt, clean the rear grille.
- Remove dust or dirt by using a dry brush.
- The unit should be cleaned at least once a month.
- Clean the appliance with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Make sure that no moisture has entered the appliance during cleaning.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- **Attention!** Turn off the appliance and disconnect the plug from the power outlet before cleaning.
- **Attention!** Do not use any alcohol, acetone, gasoline, abrasive cleaning agents, etc. to clean the plastic components. Do not use hard brushes or metal objects for cleaning.
- Risk of burning! Do not clean the appliance while still hot.
- Clean the appliance with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Make sure that no moisture has entered the appliance during cleaning.
- Never submerge the appliance in water or let water run over the heating element or appliance.
- Clean the air inlet from time to time with a fine brush.

STORAGE

- Store the appliance in a cool, dry location, away from children and pets.
- If the appliance is not used for an extended period, store it preferably in its original packaging.
- After use do not wrap the cord around the appliance as this may cause the cord to fracture. Coil cord loosely by the side of the appliance in storage.

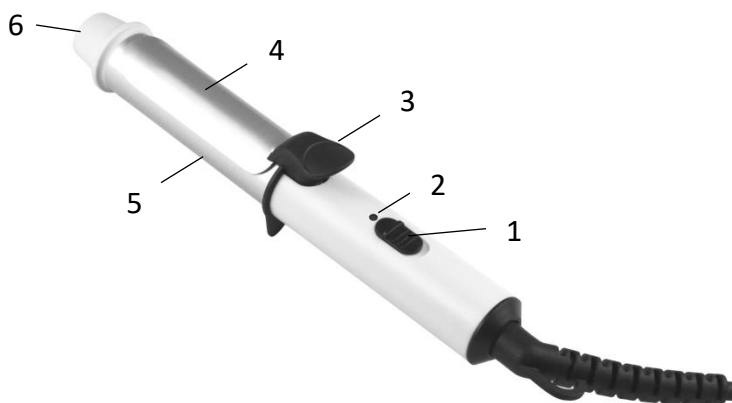

KNOW YOUR MINI CURLER



- 1. On/Off switch
- 2. Power indicator
- 3. Clamp lever

- 4. Clamp
- 5. Curling barrel

Operation

WARNING! Never touch the hot curling barrel.

WARNING! Always use the handle to hold the hair curler.

ATTENTION! The curling barrels cool down slower than heat up.

- Fully unwind the supply cord before turned on the appliance.
- Place the appliance on a smooth, flat, dry and heat resistant surface.
- Connect the power cord plug into a mains power outlet socket.
- Push the ON/OFF switch to ON position, the power indicator will light up.
- Wait until the hair curler has heated up. It takes approx. 3 minutes.

ATTENTION! The curling barrel heat up very fast.

- When the appliance is ready, you may start hair styling.

Tip: For better results, wash, comb and blow your hair until 80% dry.

- Press the clamp lever to open the clamp. Take a section of hair with no more than 3cm wide, place the ends of strands of hair between the barrel and the clamp, then release the clamp lever, so that the hair strand is fixed.
- Rotate the handle so that the strand of hair is rolled up to the roots. Maintain sufficient distance between the scalp and curling barrel.

- Hold the hair curler in position for 10-15 sections to create gentle hair waves.
- Carefully unwind the strand halfway, open the clamp and free the curled hair gently.
- Continue styling the remaining sections of hair.
- Turn off the appliance after use, make sure the power indicator has gone off.

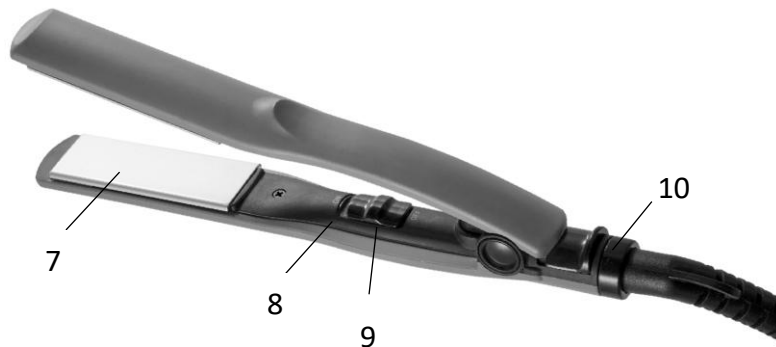
IMPORTANT! Do not leave the Hair Curler unattended when in use.

- Unplug the appliance, then put it on the table to allow for cooling.
- **CAUTION!** Allow to cool before putting it down or storing away.
- **CAUTION!** Always unplug the appliance immediately after use in case of malfunction or before cleaning.

IMPORTANT! The appliance may provide different results depending on the hair type. Therefore, we recommend carrying out a trial on a hidden area of your hair before first use.

- This hair curler is not recommended for use on damaged or bleached hair.

Operation

WARNING! Never touch the hot heating plates. Always use the handle to hold the hair straightener.

ATTENTION! The heating plates cool down slower than they heat up.

- Unlock the heat plates, and fully unwind the supply cord. Make sure the ON/OFF switch is in OFF position.
- Place the appliance on a smooth, flat, dry and heat resistant surface.
- Connect the power cord plug into a mains power outlet socket.
- Push the ON/OFF switch to ON position, the power indicator will light up.

ATTENTION! The heating plates heat up very fast. It takes approx. 3 minutes to each max. temperature.

- When the appliance is ready, you may start hair styling.
- To begin straightening hair, take a section no more than 4 to 5cm wide. Place the hair between the two flat plates as close as you can near the scalp.
- Hold the plates tight for a couple of seconds and slide the straightener in even motion towards the ends. For the best results, hold the hair while smoothing the section.

- **CAUTION! Do not hold the hair between the plates for more than a couple of seconds as this may damage/burn your hair.**
- When you have finished one section, move to another area of hair and repeat the process. Allow the hair to cool before combing through.
- After use, turn OFF the appliance, make sure the power indicator has gone off.
- Unplug the appliance from mains power and allow it to cool down.
- **CAUTION!** Allow to cool down completely before storing.
- **CAUTION!** Always unplug the appliance immediately after use in case of malfunction or before cleaning.
- **IMPORTANT!** The appliance may provide different results depending on the hair type. Therefore, we recommend carrying out a trial on a hidden inconspicuous area of your hair before first use.
- **This hair straightener is not recommended for use on damaged or bleached hair.**

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

ATTENTION! Turn off the appliance and disconnect the plug from mains power outlet, allow the appliance completely cool down before cleaning.

ATTENTION! Do not use any alcohol, acetone, gasoline, abrasive cleaning agents, etc. to clean the plastic components. Do not use hard brushes or metal objects for cleaning.

Risk of burning! Do not clean the appliance while still hot.

- Wipe the appliance with a dry cloth.
- Never submerge the appliance in water or let water run over the heating plates or the appliance.
- The heating plates can be cleaned with a slightly damp cloth and a little detergent if necessary.
- Dry thoroughly after cleaning.

STORAGE

- Store the appliance in a cool, dry location, away from children and pets.
- After use do not wrap the cord around the appliance as this may cause the cord to fracture. Coil cord loosely by the side of the appliance after use and when storing.
- If the appliance is not used for an extended period, store it preferably in its original packaging.
