Operating Instructions for TV

Direct Entry: First, you have to get your brand code from the code list and follow the steps below:

 With the TV on, face the remote in a straight line in front of your TV a a distance less than 1 metre. 2) Press the button of device (TV VCR etc.) once and release then

press and hold the SET button until the red indicator light stays on, then release the button.

3) Enter the 4 digit device code that you can find in the TV code list next to the brand name of your TV. 4) With your device on, press the CH+ button. If the device responds,

no further programming is required.

NOTE: If some buttons do not operate the TV properly, try another one

of the TV codes and repeat the steps above.

Manual Code Search: If the remote does not respond after you have tried all the codes for your brand, or you cannot find a code in the code list, you can search manually for your code by following the steps below 1) Manually turn on your unit (TV, DVD player, etc.) that you want to be

2) Press the button of device (TV VCR etc.) once and release then press and hold the SET button until the red indicator light stays on, then release the button.

3) Point the remote at your device and press the CH+/ CH- button repeatedly until the device can be powered off.

4) Once the unit is fully functional, press the OK button to save and install the code.

CAUTION:

Batteries should be removed and replaced by adults only. Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Do not recharge standard or alkaline batteries. Be sure to insert batteries with the correct polarities and always follow the battery manufacturer's instructions.

Remove batteries and store them in a cool, dry place when not in use. Always remove old and dead batteries from the product. Dispose of used batteries responsibly.

Identify Code: The Identify code function can be used after you have already entered the TV/DVD code but have forgotten it. Following the steps below, you will be able to find what your code is. 1)Press and hold the button of device (TV VCR etc.) at same time press

the OK button then release both of them. 2)For example if the code is 1085,the indicator light will blink for one time first then stop for one second, after that indicator light will blink for ten times then stop for one second, then indicator light will blink for eight times then stop for one second, then indicator light will blink

for five times then stop for one second. Sleep Function: The sleep function will turn off your TV automatically after you have programmed the time .

1) Press the SLEEP button and TV screen come out time off function 2) Adjust the time according to your need.

NOTE: The sleep function will not activate unless the remote is pointed

To turn the sleep timer OFF, press the POWER button to turn the TV off.

USING THE REMOTE TO CONTROL YOUR DEVICES

Because this remote can control more than one device, you must select which device you wish to operate. For example, if you want to operate your TV, once the remote is turned on, you must press the TV button to put the remote into TV mode. The remote will stay in the mode you select until you change it. If your remote is in TV mode, you must change it to be able to operate the DVD player, VCR, Satellite Receiver or Cable Box.

For example if your remote is in DVD mode and you want to turn off your TV, you must press the TV button first before pressing the POWER

BATTERY NOTE:

For the best results, please use alkaline batteries. Be sure to check the batteries expiration date so ensure uninterrupted use of the remote. Remove the batteries if the product will not be used for an extended period of time. If the product does not perform properly, check the batteries have not leaked or corroded, have been installed properly or if they need to be changed.

To Replace and Install Batteries

This remote requires 2 "AA" batteries. 1) Remove the battery cover on the back of the remote.

2) Insert the AA batteries with the correct poliarity as indicated in the
