General Instructions





·Add water.



②Apply dye on fabric, checking to make sure due has penetrated into folds. Do not over-saturate fabric. If dye is applied too close together, the colour may



Wran let set 6-8 hours and rinse.

©Cover dyed fabric with plastic wrap to keep damp. Let set for 6–8 hours, longer for a more intense colour. Rinse well with water until excess dye is removed. Wash and dry separately.

Read through all directions before beginning

Set up work surface
Protect your work surface with a plastic table cover or cover with a layer of paper towel.

For better dyeing, please wash the fabric first. Do not use fabric softener or dryer sheet. You can tie dye directly on wet fabric.

- 1. Dye must be used within 45 minutes of mixing. Dye left unapplied after 45 minutes will begin to lose concentration and will result in noticeably 1. Dye must be used within 45 minutes of mixing. Dye left unap weaker colour intensity,
 2. Do not add water to dye until you are prepared to apply it.
 3. Make sure excess dye dust is removed from work area.
 4. Create new colours by blending dye.
 5. Do not allow dyed fabric to rest with other items.
 6. Always use gloves when working with dyes.

HEADBAND
