INSERTING BATTERIES

 Unscrew to open battery cover, place the string to the bottom of the battery holder as shown in the figure before installing the battery, then insert 4 X 1.5 V AA batteries.



POWERING ON YOUR DOG

Once you have inserted batteries into your dog and remote control, you can go ahead and power on your dog. To do so, slide the ONIOFF switch located underneath the dog to the ON position.
When you do not operate the do for about 3 minutes. It will make a sound and enter sleep mode. When your

When you have finished playing with your dog, slide the ON/OFF switch to the OFF position.

NOTE: When your dog is running low on power, some of the functions will not be available. Once the batteries are completely depleted, replace the batteries as soon as possible to continue use.

MOVING YOUR DOG

You can use your remote control to move your dog around in different directions.

Press the forward/backward button to make the dog bark, then walk forward/backward for a distance

Press the left/right button to make the dog bark, then turn left/right for a distance.

Press the action acceleration button, the dog will enter action acceleration mode, press the forward /backward button, the dog will accelerate forward/ backward for a distance. Press the action acceleration button again to return normal mode.



PLAT

Press the play button, the dog will act playful, and will walk around and bark.

GUARD

Press the guard button, the dog will act protectively and will make a "woof, woof, woof" sound.

PATROL MOD

Press the patrol mode button, the dog will walk back and forth.

PROGRAMMING YOUR DOG

Press the program button and your dog will enter program mode

Once in program mode, you can press any buttons on the controller (except motion sensing button / Infrared sensor button) to create a movement program. The dog can be programmed with up to 30 actions. Press the program button again to have your dog carry out the movement program that you created.

MOTION SENSING

Press the motion sensing button and your dog will enter motion sensing mode.

Once in motion sensing mode, you can full control of direction including forward, backward, left and right turning through your gestures.







INFRARED SENSOR FUNCTION

Press the infrared sensor button and your dog will enter infrared sensor mode. (The signal indicator on remote control will light up)

Once in infrared sensor mode, aim the infrared signal light on the remote control at the infrared sensor on the doc, then the doc will move in the direction of the remote control.
