## Tie Dye Jewellery



### SET UP:

- 1. Cover your work area with plastic covering, such as a plastic tablecloth or garbage bag.
- 2. Prewash and dry the fabric before dyeing. This will remove anything in the fabric that prevents the due from being absorbed.
- 3. Have all tools you need at the work area.

#### START:

- 1. Wear old clothes or an apron.
- 2. Fill the bottle with water and replace the cap tightly, shake the bottle until the dye is completely
- 3. Lay the fabric out flat on the working table, fold, twist or scrunch the fabric.
- 4. Wear gloves and spray the dye onto your bracelet wrap.
- 5. Put your dyed fabric into a plastic bag (not included), simply leave the closed bag in a safe place, the dye will need to set for 24 hours.
- 6. Remove your dyed fabric from the plastic bag and check out your design.
- 7. Fill a bucket (not included) with water, place your dyed fabric in the bucket, and rinse the fabric well until excess dye is removed, then hang to dry.
- 8. Thread the beads to create your own unique bracelet.

For brighter colours, add less water into the dye powder, for lighter shades, add more water.
