- 2. Freely mix up colours to create new ones.


DIRECTIONS 1:

- 1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
- 2. Cover work area with newspaper or paper towel.
- 3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
- 4. Put on an apron or art smock before you paint.
- 5. Paint on the rock multiple times to make the colour brighter.
- 6. Keep a cup of water to clean the paint brush after applying each colour.
- 7. Close the paint lid after use.
- 8. Use the transfer stickers after the paint is completely dry.


DIRECTIONS 2 - How to use the transfer sticker sheet:



Cut out the insects and plants from the sticker sheet. (scissors not included)



Tear off the plastic film on the surface of the sticker, press the printed side down on the rock, apply water to the paper side until it is completely wet.



Gently and slowly remove the white paper, and the insect is printed on the rock. (If it can't be removed, please continue to wet the paper with water until it can be easily removed.)



Paint the background to finish your own rock art. Make the other plants rocks in the same way.




DIRECTIONS 2 - How to use the transfer sticker sheet:
