PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE

Please follow all the precautions listed below for safety and to reduce the risk of injury or electric shock.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

- 1. For hygienic reasons, do not share this appliance with other people.
- 2. Only use the appliance as described in this manual.
- 3. Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- 4. Always check the appliance for damage before use. If any damage is observed, do not use the appliance.
- 5. The appliance is intended for indoor use only.
- 6. This appliance has no user-serviceable parts. Do not attempt to access the internal components in the appliance.
- 7. This appliance is for personal use only, not designed for commercial use.
- 8. Do not use it outdoors.
- 9. Before using the appliance, ensure that the shaver head is securely fitted.
- 10. Keep the appliance out of reach of young children and pets.
- 11. Do not use it on children or allow children to play with the appliance.
- 12. The appliance is not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge unless they have been given supervision or instructions concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- 13. Children must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- 14. Use only attachments provided with the product.
- 15. Detach the attachment heads for cleaning. Only the attachments can be washed under tap water.
- 16. Do not submerge the appliance, nor make it flow under the water tap.




CAUTION!

- This appliance is battery-operated. If you do not use the appliance for a long time, remove the battery.


PARTS

- 1. Outer Foil
- 2. Removable blade head
- 3. Power indicator
- 4. On/Off switch
- 5. Protective cap
- 6. Battery compartment



BATTERY REPLACEMENT

Remove the battery cover and insert one AA battery (battery is not included) according to the battery compartment instruction. Put the battery cover back on the device, and make sure it's tightly fitted.




OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



WARNING: Stop using if skin becomes sore or inflamed.

WARNING: If you feel any discomfort or irritation during use, stop using the product.

- 1. Remove the Protective Cap.
- 2. Make sure the shaver head is securely inserted into the unit.
- 3. Push the switch to turn on the unit.
- 4. Place the blade on the skin, and move it slowly and gently in circular motions to remove unwanted hair.
- 5. This appliance can be used in different body areas, such as underarms, legs, and bikini lines.
- 6. Turn off the unit after use.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Note: Clean the appliance after each use to ensure better performance.

- 1. Always switch OFF the unit before cleaning.
- 2. Do not immerse the whole unit in water.
- 3. Clean the removable blade head with a cleaning brush or rinse it under water.
- 4. Do not use any lubricant, detergent, polishing agent, or air freshener on this appliance.
- 5. Do not use towels paper towels, and wire ball sponge to clean the blade head.

RECYCLE

Batteries contain substances harmful to our environment. Please do not dispose of the appliance with the battery inside. Remove the battery and recycle it for environmental protection.
