RIB BEANIE

WITH POM POM Easy Knit

RIB BEANIE WITH POM POM

MEASUREMENTS

> To fit head (approx) 56 cm

MATERIALS

> Super Chunky 100g x 2 balls

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- > 1 pair 12mm knitting needles, or size that gives correct tension.
- > A yarn needle
- Strong sewing thread for sewing seam (to prevent a bulky seam)
- > Large pom pom maker

TENSION

> 6 sts and 9 rows to 10 cm over stocking st, using 12mm needles.

BEANIE

- Using 12mm needles, cast on 31 sts.
- > Beg rib 1st row (RS) K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.
- > 2nd row P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.
- > Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 16 cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.
- > Shape Crown 1st row K1, * sl 1, K2tog, psso, rib 3, rep from * to end = 21 sts.
- > Work 3 rows rib.
- \rightarrow 5th row K1, * sl 1, K2tog, psso, rib 1, rep from * to end = 11 sts.
- > Work 1 row rib.
- > Break off yarn leaving a long end. Run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

FINISHING

- DO NOT PRESS.
- Darn in ends.
- > Using strong sewing thread and a **flat seam**, join side edges together to form centre back seam.
- > Make a large pom pom and sew to top of beanie as pictured.
