

## Paint Your Own Easter Mug

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
2. Cover your work area with newspaper or paper towels.
3. Lay out all of your materials in front of you.
4. Put on an apron or art smock before you paint.
5. Keep a cup of water near to thoroughly wash the paint brush after applying each colour.
6. Close the paint lids after each use to prevent paint from drying.

### TIPS:

1. Add some water to the paints if they look too dry or sticky.
2. Let the painted mug dry completely after you have finished painting.
3. Refer to the packaging box as inspiration when painting, or create your own designs.
4. Mix different paints together to create new colours.
5. To achieve the best results and brightest paint colours, allow the painted mug to dry for 24 hours before use.

Tips: Mixing Blue and Pink will make a close shade to Purple.  
Mixing Yellow and Pink will make a close shade to Orange.
