# Craft UV Resin Instructions

includes:90mL/100g clear UV resin1 x pair of nitrile glovesInstructions

#### Instructions:

- Wear a pair of disposable gloves, eye protection and protective clothing. Lay down a disposable sheet over your working area.
- 2. Remove film seal on UV resin bottle and re-attach the bottle nozzle.
- 3. Twist the bottle nozzle to open and carefully pour UV resin into appropriate containment (eg. silicone mould).
- 4. Using the anko UV resin setting light (sold separately), allow the UV resin to dry. UV resin will be dry to touch.

**Note:** UV resin curing time will depend on the size of the craft project and the strength of the UV rays used. For optimum drying time it is recommended to use UV resin setting light (sold separately). Curing UV resin in layers may aid drying time (allow approximately 5 minutes when curing 4mm thick projects using the anko UV resin setting light).

If UV resin spills onto clothes or skin, rinse immediately with warm soapy water.

If UV resin gets in eyes, rinse immediately with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

If skin irritation or rash occurs: get medical advice/attention.

**CAUTION:** UV resin may become slightly warm during the curing process. Use UV resin and UV resin setting light in well ventilated area. Keep UV resin and UV resin setting light out of reach of children.
