#### Important Safety Information

Read all instructions: Before using your CD player.

> Use 2 X AA(LR6) alkaline batteries (not included)

Do not use rechargeable (NiMH, Ni-cd), lithium, carbon-zinc, or any other battery type unless explicitly stated as compatible in this manual. **Using incorrect** batteries may cause leakage, overheating, fire, or explosion.

Polarity is Vital: Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -) as marked inside the battery compartment. Incorrect installation can cause short-circuiting, leakage, overheating, fire, or explosion.

> Do Not Mix: NEVER mix old and new batteries, or batteries of different types, brands, or chemistries. Replace all batteries at the same time with new ones of the same type and brand. Mixing batteries can cause leakage, overheating, fire, or explosion.

Remove Exhausted/Unused Batteries: Remove batteries if they are exhausted or if the player will not be used for an extended period. Old or leaking batteries can cause damage to the player.

> Adult Use Only: Battery installation and replacement should be performed only by an adult.

Choking & Poisoning Hazard: Batteries are small parts. KEEP BATTERIES OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS. If swallowed, seek immediate medical attention Battery fluid is corrosive and toxic. If battery fluid contacts skin or eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.

Disposal: Do not dispose of batteries in fire or water. Do not put batteries in regular household waste. Dispose of used batteries promptly and properly according to local regulations for battery recycling. Contact your local council for safe disposal/recycling options.

Use Correct Adapter ONLY: If using an AC/DC power adapter (not included), it MUST be rated at 4.5VDC, 1A (1000mA) output and have the correct polarity. Using an incorrect or unapproved adapter can damage the player, cause overheating, fire, or electric shock,

> Check Before Use: Inspect the adapter and cable regularly for damage. Do not use a damaged adapter

Do not dispose of this unit in fire or water.

Never attempt to disassemble the unit. There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Opening the unit may expose you to dangerous voltages or other hazards and will void the warranty.

> Keep your device and all accessories (especially batteries and headphones) out of the reach of children and pets.

> Small parts may cause choking or serious injury if swallowed.


> Operating Temperature: Use the device only within an ambient temperature range of  $5^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $35^{\circ}\text{C}$  (41°F to  $95^{\circ}\text{F}$ ). Avoid exposing your device to very cold (below 5°C) or very hot (above 35°C) temperatures

> Extreme temperatures (outside the 5°C - 35°C range) can cause deforming of the device, malfunction, and significantly reduce battery performance and life. Do not allow your device to get wet. Liquids can cause serious damage and

electric shock. This device is not waterproof. > Do not handle your device with wet hands.

> Do not expose the device to dripping or splashing water. Do not place objects filled with liquids (e.g., vases) on the device.

### Important Note:

2 x AA Batteries (required for operation) are NOT included. AC/DC Power Adapter (4.5VDC, 1A output required) is NOT included.

## **Operation Instructions**

## Battery Installation

**Insert Batteries:** Open the battery compartment and insert two new "AA" size alkaline batteries (not included). CRITICAL: Ensure the battery polarity ('+' and '-') matches the markings **exactly** as indicated inside the compartment. Close the compartment securely.

## Optional AC/DC Power Adapter Use (adapter is not included):

1. Remove Batteries (IMPORTANT): If batteries are installed in the unit, remove them before connecting the adapter.

2. Connect Adapter: Insert the plug of a 4.5VDC, 1A output AC/DC power adapter into the "DC Power Jack" located on the right side panel of the unit. Then plug the adapter into a standard AC electrical outlet.

Note: Ensure the adapter meets the required specifications (4.5VDC, 1A) and polarity. Refer to the "Important Safety Information" section for full adapter usage warnings.

# How to use

## IMPORTANT NOTICE:

- Do not use scratched, warped, or damaged discs they may cause skipping, playback errors, or device malfunction.
- Always wait until the disc completely stops spinning before removal.

- 1. **Open Disc Tray:** Press the "Door Open Button". The "Disc Tray Door" will
- 2. Load Disc: Place CD/MP3 disc label-side up on the center spindle. Press gently until it clicks into place. Close the "Disc Tray Door" firmly until it
- 3. Connect Audio: Plug headphones into the "3.5mm Headphone Jack".

- 4. Start Playback: Press "Play/Pause Button" to begin Track 1
- 5. Volume Control:
- Press Volume+ to increase
- Press Volume- to decrease

WARNING: Exposure to sounds >85dB can cause permanent hearing

damage. Use at moderate volumes.

# 7. Power Management:

- Auto shutdown after 30 seconds of inactivity
- Manual off: Double press or Long-press "Stop/Power Button"
- 8. Disc Removal: Press "Door Open Button". WAIT for disc to stop spinning. Lift disc vertically from spindle, Close tray door. 9. AC Adapter Safety: After use, unplug adapter from wall outlet first, then
- disconnect from device. **NOTE:** When the low battery icon "a" flashes on LCD, replace the batteries. Replace both AA batteries immediately, Use same type/brand alkaline batteries, Observe correct polarity.

## Playback Modes:

# Repeat Mode

- > Single track: Press "Mode" until "1-©" icon appears
- > Entire disc: Press "Mode" until " icon appears > Cancel: Cycle modes until icons disappear

## Random Play

Press "Mode" until " 💢 " icon appears

- > Tracks play in shuffled orde
- > Cancel: Cucle to next mode

## Scan Mode

- Activates when SCAN icon appears
- Samples each track (10 seconds per track) > Press "Play" during scan to resume normal playback
- Directory Function (MP3 CD format with multiple files only)
- During playback: Press "DIR Button" to navigate folders.
- $\rightarrow$  Press DIR Button repeatedly to scan through folders. > Press "Play" to confirm selection

## Bass Boost Sustem (BBS):

- > Press "BBS Button" to toggle effect
- CRITICAL SAFFTY NOTES:
- Always reduce volume before activating BBS, Bass enhancement increases
- High volume + BBS may cause: Headphone/speaker damage, Instant hearing
- Recommended max volume with BBS: 70%
