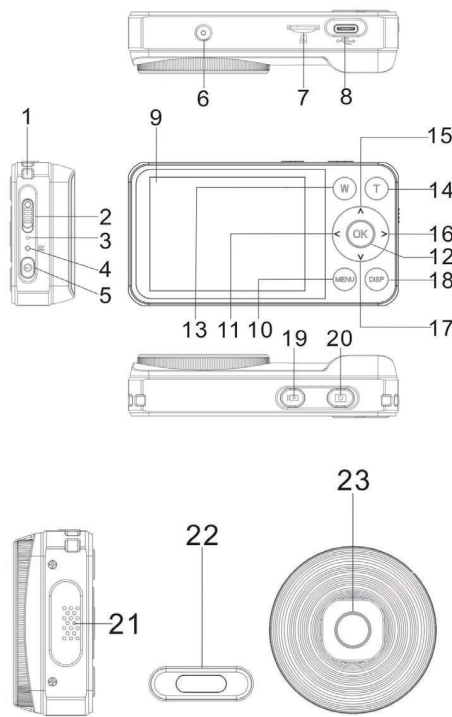

Product diagram

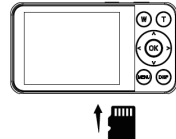


Buttons Instructions:

| 5 | Power Button | long press: Power on/off short press: Screen backlight on/off |
| 6 | Mounting Bracket Port | Fit 1/4" Screw Threaded Stand Mount (not included) |

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare to Use
Install the memory card
Insert the microSD card as shown until it clicks into place.



Usage tips:

- The camera requires a memory card to operate.
- Format the card in the camera before first use.
- Do not remove the card while the device is on, to prevent damage or data loss.
- Use a high-speed (U3 or higher) microSD card for best performance.

Charge the Product

- Charge fully before first use.
- Use the provided USB-C cable with a certified 5V/1A (or higher) adapter (not included).
- The red indicator light stays on while charging and turns off when fully charged.
- Charging time: approx. 3 hours.
- Charge the device at least once a month to maintain battery health.

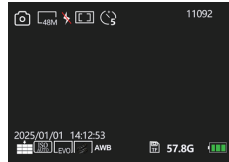
Power on/off

- Insert a memory card before using the camera.
- Long press the Power button for 3 seconds to turn on or off.

Device Defaults (No Operation)

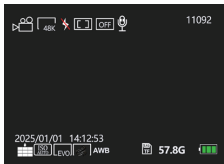
- Screen turns off after 1 minute.
- Device powers off after 3 minutes.
- To adjust these settings: enter **Settings > Screensaver/ Auto Shutdown**, select a time, then press OK to save.

How to take photos



- Set the Mode Button to **Shooting**.
- Short press the **Photo button** to take a picture.
- Use the **[T/W] buttons** to zoom in/out.
- Use the **Up button** to enable/disable flash.
- Use the **[Left (<) / Right (>)] buttons** to apply filters.
- Use the **Down button** to set time-lapse (3s/5s/10s/20s).
- To enable Selfie mode, go to **Settings > Selfie Mode**.

How to record a video



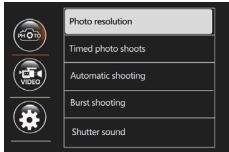
- Set the Mode Button to **Shooting**.
- Short press **MENU button** to switch to Video mode.
- Short press the **Video button** to start/stop recording.
- Use **[T/W] buttons** to zoom.
- Use the **Up button** to enable fill light.
- Use the **[Left (<) / Right (>)] buttons** to select filters.

How to view/delete files

- Set the Mode Button to **Photo Album**.
- Use **[Left (<)/Right (>)] buttons** to browse files.
- For photos: use **[T/W] buttons** to zoom; use **[Up/Down/Left/Right] buttons** to move view.
- For videos: Short press OK to play/pause; adjust volume (0–8) with **Up/Down buttons**; Long press **[Left (<)/Right (>)] buttons** to fast-rewind(-2x)/fast-forward (2x).
- To delete: Short press **MENU button**, confirm with OK.

Note: Deleted files cannot be restored. Back up important data.

How to Enter the Settings Menu/Save Settings



- Ensure the camera is not recording.
- Set Mode Button to **Shooting**.
- Long press **MENU button** to open Settings.
- Select from three menus:
 - **Photo Settings**
 - **Video Settings**
 - **System Settings**
- Navigate with **Up/Down**, confirm with **OK**, return with **MENU**.

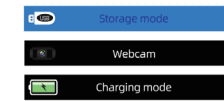

Connect to Computer

Use the provided USB-C cable to connect the camera to your computer.

The camera will display selectable modes:



- **Storage Mode:** Transfer photos and videos as a removable disk.
- **Webcam:** Use the camera as a PC webcam with video chat software.
- **Charging Mode:** Charge the camera only (no data transfer).

Notes:

- Use care when ejecting the removable disk to avoid data loss.
- If the computer does not recognise the device, reconnect or try another USB port/cable.

Common Issues and solutions

| Problem | Possible cause | Solution |
|------------------------------------|---|--|
| Device will not power on | Battery low | Charge the battery |
| Screen turns black suddenly | Power saving enabled /Low battery | Restart or recharge |
| Cannot record video or take photos | Memory card not formatted/ Incompatible or slow card/Write protection enabled | Format the card, use Class 10 or higher, remove write protection |
| "Memory card error" displayed | Card corrupted or incompatible | Format or replace with a compatible card |
| Device freezes/unresponsive | Memory card issue | Use a high-quality memory card; press Reset if needed |
| Photos/videos have abnormal colors | Incorrect settings (exposure, effects, etc.) | Adjust settings or restore factory defaults |
| Cannot connect to computer | Faulty connection or damaged cable | Reconnect or replace the USB cable |
| Battery not charging | Unsupported charger | Use a certified 5V/1A (or higher) USB power adapter |
