



NAIL GLUE

APPLICATION

1. Use nail glue only over a clean surface or table, never work with nail glue over your lap in case you spill it.
2. Clean and buff your nails
3. To open, face bottle away from your body.
4. Gently push back your cuticles with either a cuticle pusher or cuticle stick.
5. Apply a drop of adhesive to your natural nail and use the nozzle/brush to spread evenly.
6. Position the artificial nail on your natural nail and hold in place for 30 seconds until fixed.
7. Remove any excess adhesive that may have squeezed out from the nail.

REMOVAL:

1. Do not force or pull artificial nails from the natural nail.
2. Trim off artificial nail that is longer than your natural nail.
3. Soak in acetone based polish remover for 5-10 minutes and then carefully remove.

WARNING : NOT SUITABLE FOR CHILDREN UNDER 15 YEARS OF AGE

Causes skin and eye irritation. Do not apply if the nail or surrounding skin is irritated or infected. Use only in a well ventilated area. Store in a cool, dry place. Keep away from heat and flame.

Keep away from fabrics. Contact with clothes may cause damage and generate sufficient heat to burn the skin. In the event of spillage on clothing, soak in soap and water and gently remove the affected clothing. Seek medical advice if required.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Avoid contact with skin and eyes and avoid breathing vapour. Bonds on contact. Should fingers stick together apply a solvent such as acetone to contact areas then wash off with water. Do not use solvents near eyes or open wounds. In case of eye contact immediately flush with water.
