

# Product Safety Recall

## Make Your Own Unicorn Sand Ornaments – sold at Kmart and Target

Loose coloured play sand for children, including as part of a sandcastle building set.

### Reason the product is recalled:

The products are being recalled because the sand may include asbestos, which is a prohibited substance in Australia.

### The hazards to consumers:

The products may cause a risk to health as asbestos has been detected in some samples after laboratory testing.

Importantly, respirable asbestos has not been detected in any of the tested samples. The release of respirable asbestos fibres is unlikely to occur in its current state, unless the sand is processed by mechanical means such as crushing or pulverising.

The risk that any asbestos found is likely to be airborne or fine enough for inhalation is low.

### What consumers should do:

1. Stop using the product immediately.
2. Contact Kmart or Target with proof of purchase for a full refund.
